Coach's report

Hasn't time flown? Pre-season began 5 months ago for most players and it seems like only a couple of weeks ago (not 8!!) since they were involved in a tough, yet enjoyable, pre-season camp at the Boully's Pichi Richi Park. Since then we have had trial games against North Whyalla, BMW and Kimba and the season has now kicked off with good Round 1 wins in all 3 Senior Grades against Ports. I include the U/18's as a Senior team as the reality of it is we should always look to involve and teach these lads in preparation for B grade, A grade or beyond. Well done to Bill Jo Martin, Tom Hore, Dylan Barnett, Harry Holland, Caleb Ritter, Challan Stuart, Jake Ellis and Dareyan Solomon were among the U/18's who trained consistently and solidly with us over the Preseason and now look set for a big year at whatever level each attains. South have always developed it's young players well and that, along with finding improvement in the existing A/B grade is the way forward. A fact that highlights this is that the Club has lost 8 of it's 2012 A grade grand final team alone and one or two more who stepped up since (such as Wingfield and Craig Shirley).

In our Round 1 win the opportunities created by these departures were earnt by current colts and "graduates" Billy Jo Martin, Nathan Paige, Sam Maule and Slade Laube as well as players who played more Bs than As last season; Jak Kerin (1^{st} best player), David Robinson (2^{nd} best player)and Tim Amos and finally three recruits in Bowde Kelly (4 goals), Tom Hamilton and Liam Bury (5 goals). While we have a number of other players who could play A grade at South this year I will only provide some background on these three for now:

Bowde is a tall versatile player from Hornridge Magpies in Roxby Downs and won their A grade Best and Fairest trophy in 2013. He has a strong set of hands, a raking left foot kick and can play anywhere forward or back and also in the ruck. He had an impressive debut and , at 19 years of age, he will learn plenty and adapt very well to SGL footy as the season rolls on. Please go out of your way to welcome Bowde and his family and if you have a couple of spare beds let us know so we can be as accommodating as possible towards them.

Tom Hamilton comes to us from Central Whyalla and prior to that Eastern Park in Adelaide. Having coached Tom last season in Whyalla, where he came runner up in the clubs Best and Fairest, top 5 in the medal and equal 3rd in the League goalkicking I am sure he will have a big impact in the SGL. (One of the Ports lads felt that impact last week!) Tom is a strongly built mid-sized player, with pace and decent leap. Tom is a very attacking player and loves a goal. His nickname is "Flex" (you can ask why), his partner is Kayla and they have a 3-4 year old son Ryley.

Liam Bury and his sidelined brother Keenan have come to us from BMW. The Burys are from Quorn and have connections with South. I believe their Dad, Darren, played some footy at South, Darren's cousin definitely did and Kent, the late brother of Mum, Andrea, was a very good player at the Club. Both the boys are living and working in Port Augusta now so it made sense for them to come to South

Augusta. I was lucky enough to coach Liam at BMW where he progressed from Senior Colts to A grade straight away at BMW. The last couple of years it seems Liam struggled for A grade opportunities (another who played more Bs than As last year) yet made our Round 1 team, kicked 5 goals and helped out with a couple more. Liam shared the full forward post in the first game and has the ability to play onball, half forward and half back also. He leads well and has a well balanced kicking action, rarely missing from a set shot. His girlfriend is Sam Boully who is the daughter of past player Nic and Jodie Boully. Liam is only 20 and will be a good player at South for years to come.

In being able to add the players mentioned to a strong existing group we feel we have good depth in the Club and while numbers at training continue to be 40+ we are confident that the overall form and fitness of the playing group will continue to develop as the season progresses. We are aware that despite the Round 1 win we will face potentially bigger challenges in the weeks ahead and will place a high value on these early games in the hope of putting some daylight between ourselves and the opposition below us.

We hope to have your continued support (and patience when necessary) as we strive for success in 2014!



1964 A Grade premiership side Half Backlines


Gordon Harbridge: Half Back Flank

Gordon played senior football for the club between 1959 to 1971 and was a long term player for the club. Every dependable 'Bud" Harbridge as he was known contributed well on the day, turning away many Port attacks and providing support to wingman Billy Baker when required.




Max Chynoweth: Centre Half Back

Max was recruited from West Adelaide in 1962 as a playing coach and was a highly skilled and strong key position player. He was replaced as coach after 1 year but continued to play good football for the club for the next 2 years and was an important part of the 1964 success. He came out of retirement in 1967 with West Augusta football club but his career was cut short by a massive "shirt fronter" from South strongman Neil Brooks. Max was as colourful off the field as he was on it and he died in Pt Broughton over 5 years ago.



Mick Hobby: Half Back Flank

Word has it that Mick use to take out his own players at training he was so competitive. He was also an excellent pace bowler in Port Augusta but his fading eyesight may have played a part in him often causing injury to fellow team mates. Mick played Senior football for the club between 1960 and 1965 and was a close checking backman, giving nothing away.
