Management Committee Report



Welcome to the South Augusta Clubroom Farewell weekend and welcome back to any supporters and past players and officials who have travelled to attend the weekend before we move to the new facility. We have our Liquor Licence, this was passed Thursday 9th April. The lease went to a Council Meeting Monday 13th April for the council seal then we hope to have the lease signed Friday 17th April. All moving forward a lot faster now. Final date to be trading from the Central Oval complex is still to be determined however after the first game 25th April we aim to serve from our new club rooms.

On Wednesday 8th April Responsible Service of Alcohol Training was held with a fantastic 19 members attending. A huge thank you to Mark Turner from the Career Employment Group who donated his time and waived the normal fee for this course, making himself and CEG GOLD SPONSORS. With his many people trained and willing to volunteer this will hugely benefit the club with the operation of three bars at the new complex, saving the club on wages. Thank you again to everyone who gave up their time for this course. It was very informative and educational for all participants. Hopefully none of our members/supporters/patrons will ever get to the stage where service is refused or even worse are barred from the club for a certain period of time as the consequences can be severe.

The basketball grand final weekend was the club's first big event at the new complex and overall went really well, a few minor issues were raised which we will rectify and the issues we would not have been able to foresee without being in the complex. All in all we were very happy with the event and behaviour of the wider community.

William Arthur ANDERSON , Played for South Augusta 1919

Frederick Albert BARTSCH , Played for South Augusta 1919

Thomas Robert BRENNAN , Played for South Augusta 1912-1913

George Evan MORGAN , Played for South Augusta 1925-1930

Henry Jamer Everingham PARKINSON , Played for South Augusta 1925

Henry James Thomas PARTRIDGE , Played for South Augusta 1914- 1916 and 1920

Edward Smoker, played for South Augusta in 1930.

Frank Woodforde, played South from the period 1941 to 1951.

Eric Mortlock, played for South from 1939 to 1941

Alec Merrill, played for South in the period 1939 to 1947

Ken Higginson, played for South Augusta over the period from 1944 to 1955.

Maurie Hill, played for South Augusta from 1950 to 1951.

Reg Flanagan, played for South over the period 1934 to 1943.

Cliff Grantham, played for South from 1942 to 1949 .

Wayne Shepherd and Ray Kohler: Vietnam veterans include Wayne Shepherd, who played in the 1972 B Grade Premiership , playing several years and also trainer for the club and Ray Kohler who played for the club.

Harry Waterworth Senior : Harry and Colin Waterworth's father, Harry who was a trainer at the club for several years was enlisted in the Navy in the Second World War. Harry's grandson John, also joined the Airforce and served in Afghanistan for 6 months, he is currently still in the services

Pat White: Trevor Whites father Pat was a sponsor for the club for several years. Pat was a prisoner of war in the Second World War working on the Burma railway.
