Sad to hear the news of another of the 1964 A Grade premiership side player recently passing away with Jimmy Anderson, the best player in the final joining Bob Nowak who died earlier in the year. Amongst the first Indigenous players to have played for the club, Jimmy was in his 70's and died in Darwin, his home city. Recruited for 1 year in 1964, the on-baller played a great game on the day and was named best player in the local paper stating "The outstanding display at centre by Jim Anderson completely justified South Augusta recall of him from Darwin 6 weeks ago. He played with rare judgement and great pace. His courage had no limit and his stamina was tremendous. He fought like a tiger for South Augusta from the start to their glorious finish." South won by 2 pints against Port in what is rated as our best premiership in the competition of 12 teams. Jimmy was also a legend in Darwin, having made the NT Hall of Fame, played for West Perth and several premierships for the Buffaloes. Jimmy's grandson's Jed and Jo Anderson have played AFL football for North Melbourne and Carlton and more recently granddaughter Jasmine was part of the victorious Adelaide Crows Ladies squad. Jim Averis who was one of Souths oldest surviving players also recently died. Jim who was aged 92 played for the club from 1944-1947 and was described by Ray Miller in the South Centenary book as one of the best backman in that era. Jim was named in South's best players in the grand final lost to Central in 1944 and was also in the best in other finals losses in subsequent years. Jim worked in the Railways for many years players and was well respected within the Community. The club offers its condolences to the friends and families of Jimmy Anderson and Jim Averis at this sad time.
