In the Grand final South 4.7 defeated West 3.9.

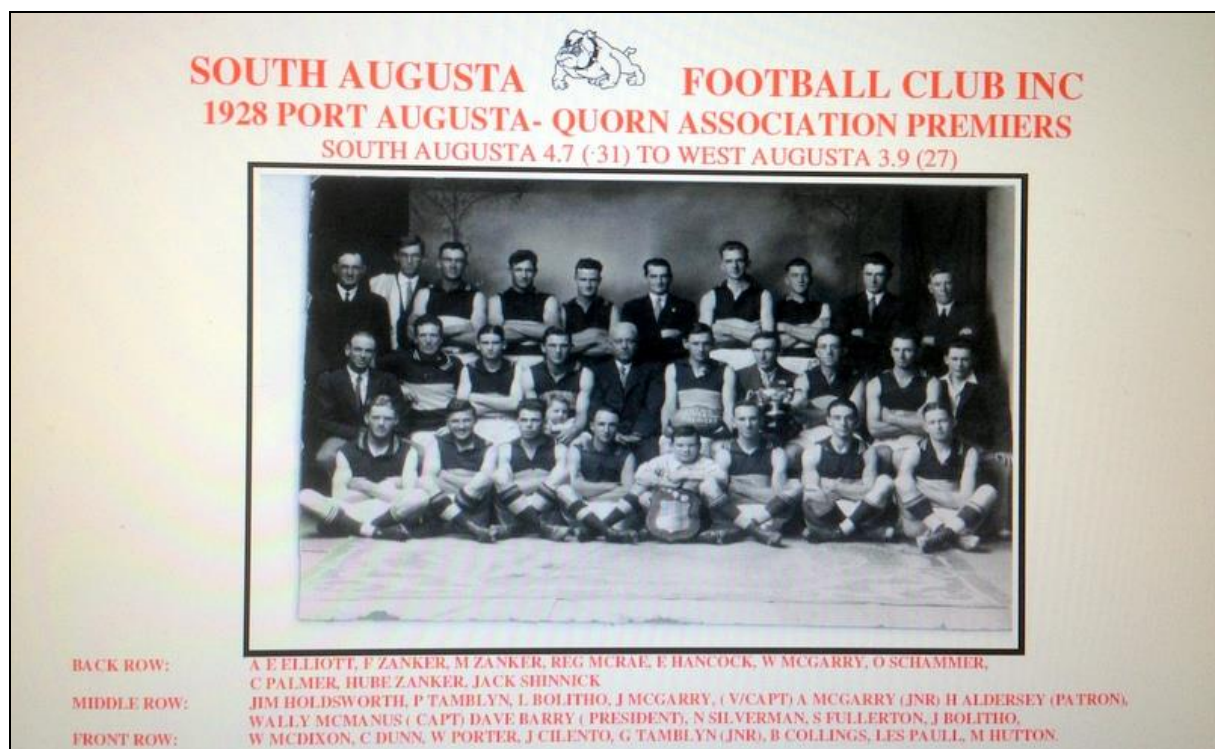

Edward Smoker: Edward Smoker was born on the 20th March 1908 and played for South Augusta in 1930. Edward joined the Army as a private from 1944 to 1946 when he enrolled in New Guinea.

Frank Woodforde: Frank Woodforde was born on the 17/1/1919 and played South from the period 1941 to 1951. He served in the Armoured Regiment of the Army from August 1941 to March 1946 as a Private. **Eric Mortlock:** Eric Mortlock played for South from 1939 to 1941 and then enrolled in the Airforce from 1942 to 1945 as a leading Aircraftman. He enlisted at Port Augusta.

Alec Merrill: Alec Merrill born on the 5/10/23 played for South in the period 1939 to 1947 and joined the Army from April 1944 to December 1946 as a Private.

Ken Higginson: Ken Higginson was born in 1927 and played for South Augusta over the period from 1944 to 1955. During this time when he did not play football when he was an Able Seaman on the HMS Lonsdale and he was enlisted in the Navy from May 1945 to February 1947.
