GREAT START TO CONNOR'S CAREER

In the last month ex -South Augusta Junior Connor Rozee has played his first AFL game, kicked 2 goals in the second game and 5 goals in his third and best player for Port Power for an excellent start to his AFL career. He was also rewarded with Rising Star nomination that week.

Connor is well on the way of emulating other South Augusta Juniors who have played at the AFL level including Jared Rivers (150 games Melbourne and 44 Geelong Total 194 games) and Bryan Bienke (38 games Adelaide Crows and 107 games Port Adelaide SANFL).

Comments from articles in papers and website: "Connor Rozee's five-goal performance was electric and one of the best games from a first-year player the Gabba has seen for many years.

Not only was Rozee dangerous in the forward 50m, the number five draft pick was confident when drifting up the ground, finishing with 21 disposals and seven marks.

Port Adelaide assistant coach Brett Montgomery has been involved in AFL football as both a player and a coach for more than 20 years and he hasn't seen a teenage draftee more mentally prepared than Connor Rozee.

Rozee, the No.5 pick in last year's NAB AFL Draft, has received the round three nomination for the NAB AFL Rising Star award after a remarkably mature five-goal performance in a losing team against Brisbane at the Gabba.





Congratulations to 3 South Augusta players who were recently inducted into the Port Augusta Hall of Fame for services to football in the region. Anthony Anno, Kym Maule and Shane Kennedy were inducted into the Hall of Fame at a dinner at West Augusta on Monday night. Shane was nominated for his additional services to the Football Umpiring in Port Augusta



ANTHONY ANNO: Originally from a rugby league background in Qld Anthony played for the club between 1988 to 2008 having played 209 A Grade games and 110 B Grade games for a total of 319 Senior games. Anthony was Captain of the A Grade side between 1998 to 2003 and was captain of the A Grade premiership side in 2000 under Coach Peter Rivers after also playing in the 1993 and 1994 A Grade Premierships and several B Grade Premierships. Anthony coached the A Grade side from 2009 to 2010, taking the 2010 team to the Grand Final. He won the Fairest and Best in 1997 and is a Life Member of the SGL, more recently assisting with the coaching of the B Grade side and Runner. He was nominated for the Port Augusta Football League Ruby Anniversary, the best 22 players between 1961 and 2011.



KYM MAULE: Kym played for the club from 1982 to 1995 with 127 League games and 29 seconds games including the 1983 A Grade Premiership side and a State Country representative on 2 occasions during the early 1980's. Kym served on the Clubs Management committee being Vice president in 1994 and 1995 and Secretary 2006-2007. Kym won the clubs A Grade Fairest and Best in 1989 and coached the B Grade in 1997. Kym has been a tireless worker for the club, assisting on the clubs BBQ, counter meals, club functions and voluntary bar work. He has been selected as Clubperson of the year and more recently been the Team Manager for the A Grade Premierships sides, assisting James Boles and his assistants. Kym is a Life member of the club and a worthy recipient.

Several of these players are mentioned below: **Edward Smoker**: Edward Smoker was born on the 20th March 1908 and played for South Augusta in 1930. Edward joined the Army as a private from 1944 to 1946 when he enrolled in New Guinea. **Frank Woodforde**: Frank Woodforde was born on the 17/1/1919 and played South from the period 1941 to 1951. He served in the Armoured Regiment of the Army from August 1941 to March 1946 as a Private.

Eric Mortlock: Eric Mortlock played for South from 1939 to 1941 and then enrolled in the Airforce from 1942 to 1945 as a leading Aircraftman. He enlisted at Port Augusta.

Alec Merrill: Alec Merrill born on the 5/10/23 played for South in the period 1939 to 1947 and joined the Army from April 1944 to December 1946 as a Private.

Ken Higginson: Ken Higginson was born in 1927 and played for South Augusta over the period from 1944 to 1955. During this time he did not play football when he was an Able Seaman on the HMS Lonsdale and he was enlisted in the Navy from May 1945 to February 1947.
