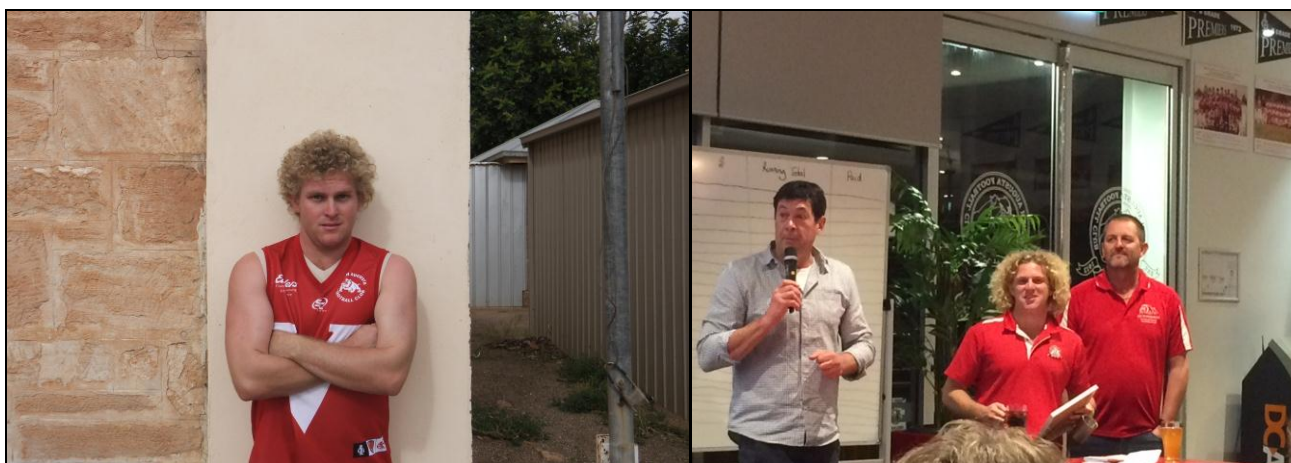

Please see related clause : ***Entrance fees (s. 6) A person must not enter the recreation ground / part of the recreation ground to which access is restricted by the controlling body, unless the person pays the entrance fee (if any) / is otherwise authorised by the controlling body to enter. Maximum penalty: \$500.*** In addition any persons found undertaking this practise may be denied access to this facility for a period of up to 4 weeks.
