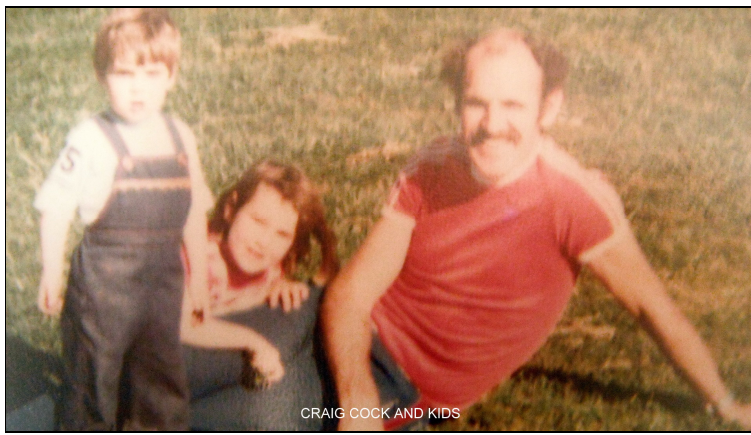
Where are they now- Craig Cock

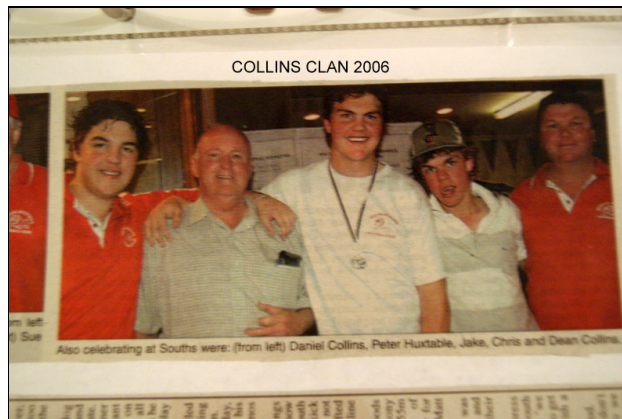

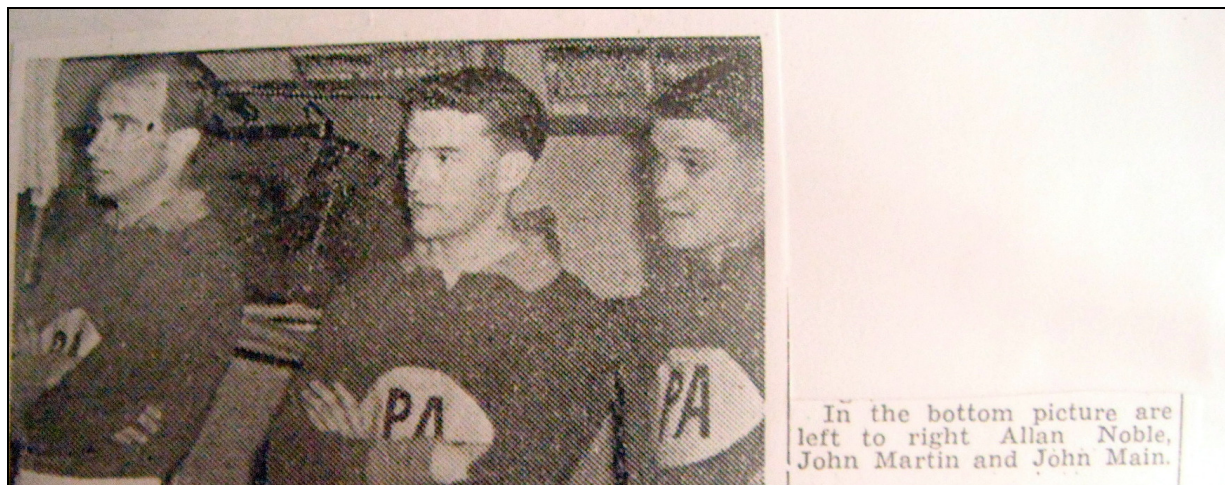
