A brief rundown on the changes are:-

- Spouses of Life Members must be financial members of the club to be deemed Associate Life Members, and they will be given full voting rights at any special general meetings of the club
- Slight change to the Social Committee, basically The Social Committee is responsible for all matters relating to and associated with the conduct of the club's functions and fundraising activities, it won't have specific numbers or Executive as such but can be formed to organise and promote events and fundraising in collaboration with the clubs Event organiser
- A main one was the ability for the Football Committee to make a call early about the appointment of the Coaches and Head Trainer without having to advertise, and the Management Committee to ratify the decision in the minutes of a committee meeting.
