
Pre- season has started with at least 37 names already on the list that have turned up it all looks good for another good season.

It has been a sad 2 months for the club with the deaths of Sharon Bury the wife of ex Club Ruckman Toby Bury, 1990 Fairest and Best Steve Dryburgh and more recently Life member and 1961 Fairest and Best Bob Nowak.

Steve Dryburgh played for the club for 2 years, playing 34 A Grade games in 1990 and 1991 after being recruited from Roxby Downs as an on-baller. He was a great player for the club over those 2 years travelling each week and performing to a high standard, lifting the other players in the team with his tough determined attitude and he played no small part in the club making the Grand Final in 1991, losing narrowly to Central Augusta. Steve had an outstanding year in 1991 and also represented the club with SGL representation. Steve lived in Qld but remained in touch with the club, returning for the 100 year celebrations in 2012 and still kept in touch with players and friends from that era. Steve will never be forgotten and with his recent illness he fought on regardless ultimately falling to cancer several weeks ago. RIP Steve and the club offers its condolences to Steve's family at this sad time.

Another legend of the club Bob Nowak played for South's from 1948 to 1964, being a member of the famous 1964 A Grade premiership team, a team that won the Premiership when the SGL consisted of 12 teams and certainly one of our best wins defeating Port by 2 points in the final. Bob played over 150 games for the club and represented the Port Augusta Football League in Inter-town football on many occasions, including the famous draw against Whyalla in 1959 and the SGL team in 1961 the same year he won the Fairest and Best. Bob also served on the Management Committee for several years as well and Bob's father Leo was also a legend of the club and Port Augusta Hall of Fame recipient. The club offers its condolences to Peggy and her family at this sad time and he will be remembered for many years to come as a great contributor to the club both on and off the field.
