

#### Meet the Coach

As current A Grade Coach he has taken the team to 3 Premierships in a row and is back to try again



in 2019 but do you know much about the player James Boles? Here is a summary from a book written about Mail Medallists and Trans Medallists, a medal that which will now not be presented thanks to the wisdom of the SGL.

"From his initiation in 1976 James became a household name in the SGL and country football generally. Apart from 1985 when he played 5 games for North Adelaide A Grade and in 1991/92 when he played for Central Whyalla and won 2 Fairest and Bests, James was always a Willsden player playing 411 SGL games, a current record.

The long serving captain won Transcontinental medals in 1982, 83 and 1990 and a Madigan medal in 1982. Only Kevin McSporran has won more medals in Port Augusta Football. James has been a State Country player 5 times and was selected in the All Australian country team once and twice selected as SA best player. He coached Willsden in 1982 and has also coached Central

Augusta for a short period before a break and then South Augusta.
