WE REMEMBER THE 1964 PREMIERSHIP.

It's been 50 years since the 1964 A Grade premiership and we plan to honour the players at the Presentation night. Each month we will recognise 3 of the players from the 1964 Premiership side who will hold their reunion on the South Augusta Presentation night on the 11th October. This month we start with the backlines with Back pocket Ross McHugh, Fullback Keith McInnes and back pocket Bob Nowak.

In 1964 the loss of Reg Richards to Adelaide was a big loss however it did recruit well at the start of the year with the inclusion of Jimmy Anderson from Darwin, Wally Reddaway, Ray Hanrahan and Mick Vanvacas being amongst the new players at the club.

Under the guidance of A grade Coach Trevor Searle South defeated Ports in the Grand Final, South 11-17 to Port 11-15. Best players in the final were Bill Virgo, Jim Anderson, Mick Vanvacas, Sam Moore, David Shillabeer, Ray Hanrahan, Gordon Harbridge and Trevor Searle.

The crowd was reportably 7,000 - 8,000 and it is regarded as the clubs best Premiership as it was in a 12 team competition. Club Champion Bill Virgo won the Transcontinental medal this year and Jack Fullerton was made Life member of the club.

Ross was determined backpocket who gave nothing away, Ross played for the club between 1963- 1966 and played a big part in holding off a persistent Ports forward line in the last half. Ross went on to have a successful sign writing business in Port Augusta " Rosssigns" and moved to Central Augusta in 1967 , but we won't hold that against him, will we!



Keith McInnis- fullback

Keith was a player Life member and played Senior football for Souths between 1949- 1964, including the A Grade Premiership. Keith was aged 30 when he played in the final and he played in a Seconds Premiership in his first year 1949 and a League premiership in his last year - 1964. He served on the Management Committee from 1961-1963 and as secretary for 1 year. Keith successfully managed the Flinders Hotel for several years after he retired from football and was involved with the Racing industry. Keith died this week on the 17th March 2014 aged 80 years.



Bob Nowak- backpocket

Robert played senior football for Souths from 1948-1964 and played over 150 games for the club including being part of the 1964 A Grade premiership side. In 1959 Robert won the A grade trophy for best Centreman and from 1958-62 he was on South's Management

committee. He made the SGL side in 1961 and Port Augusta side in 1962. In 1950 he was B Grade Vice-Captain rising through the ranks to become a great player for the club.
