Cricket Grand Final Cricket Report

A Grade - After a great effort to make it to the GF the boys were beaten by the better team on the day, Willsden. Aaron Vater continued his outstanding season with 4/23 off 10 overs and David Robinson 2/40. Chasing in a GF is never easy when we lost a few early wickets we were under the pump. We were all out for 117 with 10 overs remaining; Best with the bat were Wes Yates 32 and Craig Shirley 18. Congratulations to Aaron Vater who won the Association Bowling Agg with 38 wkts and Marcus Kerin who won the Association fielding trophy.

Congratulations also to Mick Kerin who won the Charlie Rowbottom Medal for the Associations top umpire.

B Grade - After losing only 1 game for the season the B Grade started hot favourites in the GF and delivered with a comprehensive win.

Bowling first James Harrison put the clamps on the Quornies early before their middle order got going and posted a very competitive score of 167 off their 40 overs. Best with the ball were James Harrison 2/19, Shane Adams 2/26 and Tyler Tennant 2/33
