

Tony Sullivan played for South Augusta from 1980 to 1987 amassing 85 A Grade games and 23 B Grade games. Tony started as a teacher at Blinman for his first job after University and was recruited to the club when he received a call in the towns only Public phone box from the coach at the time John Reid. He was walking down the main street of the town of 50, when the local post office master told him he had a call in the public phone box, John used every method to recruit in those days! Sully had played with Kernas at Glenelg and he quickly became part of the scene at Souths travelling every weekend to play until the Blinman school closed and he moved to Port

Augusta. Tony played in the 1981 A Grade Premiership and was a great wingman and forward for the club. One of his claim to fames was that he kicked 18 goals in a B Grade game, some say he stood the

bus driver from Sollies! Sully is currently on leave, may retire after being a school principal and inspector in Adelaide and he and his wife Deb have 3 children. Might see him at the player's reunions we have planned this year in 2019.
