#### SOUTH WAR HISTORY

On Anzac day Cameron asked what information we had on South Augusta players participation in the war so he could address the players about this. We have limited knowledge on this however further research has indicated that several South players were involved in the Wars over the years. Attached is a quick summary:

Harry Partridge played for South Augusta from 1914 to 1920 and enrolled in the Volunteer Defence Corps as a private from 1941 to 1943 at the age of 44 years.

Edward Smoker was born on the  $20^{th}$  March 1908 and played for South Augusta in 1930. Edward joined the Army as a private from 1944 to 1946 when he enrolled in New Guinea.

Frank Woodforde was born on the 17/1/1919 and played South from the period 1941 to 1951. He served in the Armoured Regiment of the Army from August 1941 to March 1946 as a Private.

Eric Mortlock played for South from 1939 to 1941 and then enrolled in the Airforce from 1942 to 1945 as a leading Aircraftman. He enlisted at Port Augusta.

Alec Merrill born on the 5/10/23 played for South in the period 1939 to 1947 and joined the Army from April 1944 to December 1946 as a Private.

Ken Higginson was born on 3/2/27 and played for South over the period from 1944 to 1955. During this time he was an Able Seaman on the HMS Lonsdale when he joined the Navy from May 1945 to February 1947.

Maurie Hill was born on the 20/7/1920 and played for South from 1950 to 1951. He served in the Army from May 1941 to January 1946.

Reg Flanagan was born 26/1/18 and played for South over the period 1934 to 1943. Reg joined the Airforce as a leading Aircraftman from Jan 1944 to June 1946.

Cliff Grantham was born on the 4/3/19 and played for South from 1942 to 1949 . He was involved in the Army from 1942 to 1944.

Vietnam veterans include Wayne Shepherd, who played in the 1972 B Grade Premiership, playing several years and also trainer for the club and Ray Kohler who played for the club.

Those with connections to war veterans include Catering manager Trevor White who's father Pat was a sponsor for the club for several years. Pat was a prisoner of war in the Second World War working on the Burma railway and Harry and Colin Waterworth's father, Harry who was a trainer at the club was involved in the Navy in the Second World war, being involved with some close calls involving sinking ships!
