The Players need to know some general information about their conditions. This year the club provides each player in A/B and Under 18s with a meal and a soft drink after the game. The \$25 single membership assists the club to cover the high cost of insurance each year. Some clubs in Amateur league in Adelaide ask their players to pay \$200 or more for the privilege

of playing so we aim to get you all on board this year at a very low cost. Don't forget that if you need to go to a physio through an injury caused through football you will be covered to a certain degree by the club's insurance. We expect players to have their own Private medical and St Johns Ambulance. See Mick Kerin for more details.
