

Brian Shillabeer and Jarrod Waterworth inducted into Port Augusta Hall of fame

Congratulations to both lads on a great achievement last month.



Life member Jarrod Waterworth played for the club from 1988 to 2007 a total of 20 years of playing service for the club, 200 A Grade games, 126 B Grade games including A Grade premierships in 1993, 1994 and 2000 and B grade premierships in 1990 and 1991. A product of South's Colts Jarrod won the A grade Fairest and Best in 1996 and has assisted A grade coaches for several years in the 2000's including with A Grade Premiership Coach Peter Rivers in 2012. Jarrod is still involved with the club as a trainer and Junior assistant coach and mentor in the under 15s.



Life member Brian Shillabeer played 149 A Grade games and 177 seconds games a total of 326 senior games, by coincidence the same total as Jarrod Waterworth. Brian played from 1977 to 1997 including an A Grade premiership in 1993 and B Grade premierships in 1978,79,81,90,91 and 1995 (Captain) . Brian coached the B Grade in 1986 and served on the Football Committee from 2002 to 2005. He received SGL life membership this year as well after many years on the SGL Tribunal.

South loses to Stirling in the Grand Final after a greatly improved year. Captain Trevor Searle won the toss and asked Stirling to bat. Stirling 8/397 defeated South's 150. Stirling had 2 centuries makers in the Grand Final including Brian Grantham 143 and Chris Jackson 117 and with Jim Maule making 48 they made a huge total. South's dropped 15 catches and this was the highest grand Final total for many seasons costing them the match. Bowling figures for South's, Ray Hanrahan 2/99, Bruce Curtis 0/62, John Kernahan 2/76, R Coulter 4/108, John Gloede 0/17 and Brian Fox 0/28.
