The gates to Central Oval will be closed from noon on Friday 23rd Sept and open at 7:30 am on Saturday, cars will be checked for alcohol on Saturday as they enter Central Oval. Facebook page will have some info relating to the day. Access to the club/venue for teas/access on Friday will be via the pedestrian gates. We have negotiated with the Council to have some security lights on the light towers until around 10:30 Sat night.

After footy access to the club will be for members, players, sponsors and invited guests only. There will be door people checking validity, all over 18 will be issued with a wrist band, there will be security. A DJ starts around 9.

Meals will be available from 6:00 until 8:00 and will be \$15/head

A and B players and match day officials will receive 3 drink vouchers for **tap beer only or soft drink**, the tickets can't be changed for other drinks, and they have to buy their own meal.

The committee has decided to handball the meals to a caterer and have rostered staff on to hopefully cater for the numbers, but we may require some help initially with handing out wrist bands, being a runner for the night to help with minor things that happen on the night, there will be a lot of little jobs eg: checking toilet paper levels, making sure bins are emptied, drinkware/plates etc are picked up, raffles, maybe going to cool room to get stock etc, etc. Just see Jodie, Judith or myself on the night and we allocate a task, any help on the night would be appreciated.

Sunday will be open from 10:30 with brunch at 11 and throughout the day pies, pasties etc will be available

South will be operating under strict guidelines as to the serving of alcohol and will not tolerate inappropriate behaviour, we want the night and the following days to be enjoyable for all and seek cooperation from all the patrons to act in a civilised manner.
