- > unruly or disruptive behaviour will not be tolerated, Security will be instructed to remove anyone that is unruly, there will be no exceptions.
- > If a member / or player/ official or any one for that matter that causes any trouble they should be aware that they will be removed from the premises and may be banned from the club.
- Please be aware that the balcony, lift, stairs are dry areas and no alcohol is allowed in these areas, as a South member you can ask people to move back into the club, contact a Committee member if you need to, Security will be monitoring. The club has been visited on numerous occasions over the last 2 or 3 years by liquor licensing officers and police, we have been questioned a couple of times about a few things, but have come up clear, the Committee intend to keep it that way. <u>DARCY WINS ANOTHER MADIGAN MEDAL</u> (Article courtesy of the Transcontinental)

South Augusta's Darcy Kildea won his second Madigan Medal recently together with the Transcontinental Medal as top Port Augusta footballer. Darcy joins another legend of the club Bill Virgo as the only 2 players to win 2 SGL Madigan Medals. Souths Kriston Thompson also finished off a great year by finishing in the top votegetters.

Kildea, a teacher in Port Augusta, led for most of the count and consolidated his position in the final stages. Modestly, he said he had not expected the win and paid tribute to his teammates. "I really didn't think I was going to win this, hence the thongs and hat that I am wearing," he told the gathering of league, umpiring and club representatives.

"Kriston Thompson had a better year. It is like getting an 'A' on a group project and you didn't do anything." He thanked the club, his family and his girlfriend Kate for their support.

Later, he told *The Transcontinental* that Kriston Thompson "gets the hard ball" for the club in the midfield. "I hang from the outside and get the cheap kicks, really," he said.

He started his football career on Kangaroo Island at 10 years old, progressing through Westminster Old Scholars and a team in the APY Lands before joining the Bulldogs.

He said "mateship" was the best thing about football. Kildea teaches at Port Augusta Secondary School. He won the medal in 2017.

South Augusta midfielder Will Waterworth polled 20 votes to win the under 18 Bishop Medal. He followed the steps of his father Jason Waterworth who played for South.

He likes the social aspects of football, including meeting new people on combined game trips. Will is an apprentice electrician with PKB Electrical.

Other South augusta players to do well this year include Seconds top-scorer: Ben Trewartha (South) 32 goals, Under 18 top-scorer: Kallan Warren (South) 76 goals and Heath Green who was Runner Up in the Under 15s Association Medal, well done to these players on their great years.

South Augusta have now had players win 5 Madigan Medals in the last 10 years with Ryan Struck, Lee Schmidt and Aziel Stuart , last year being among the other winners.
