WOMEN`S MATCH(ES)

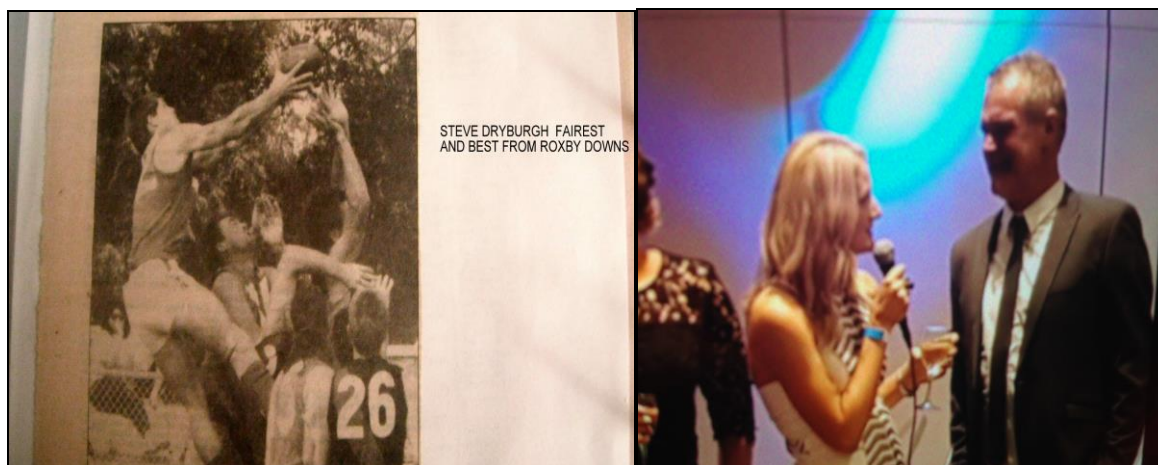

NAB INTRODUCER PROGRAM

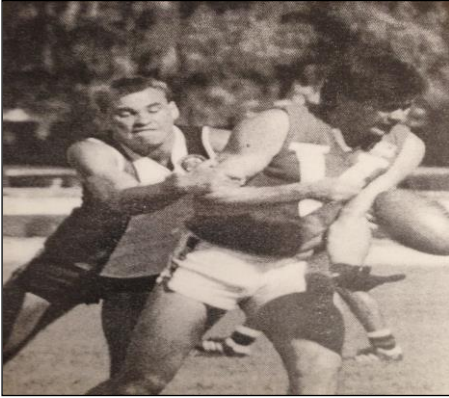

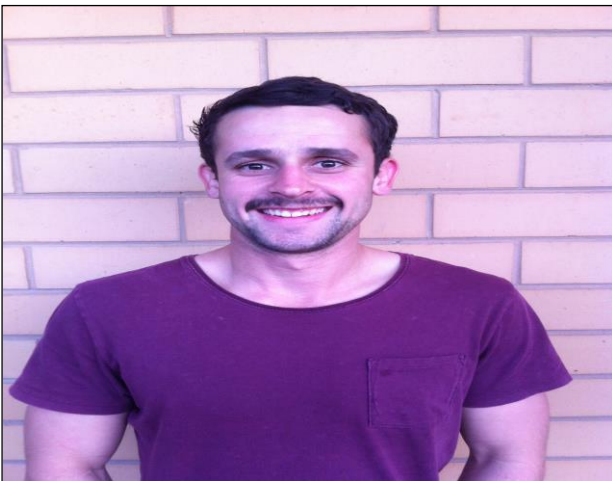


Steve in action in 1991, marking over the top of Buck Everett and more recently at his 50th with his daughter
