We thank Port Augusta Netball for also shifting some of their Saturday games to help meet this crowd issue.

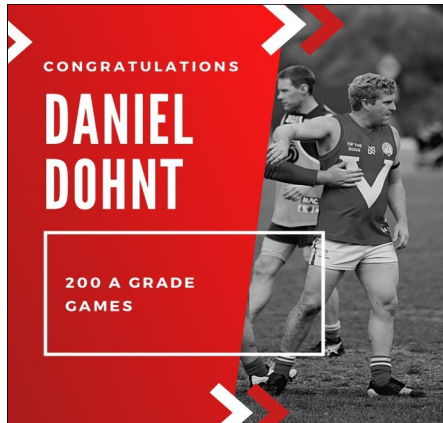
Please also note normal Friday night meals will still be on and, as you know, it is a great view to watch a game.

PLAYER MILESTONES

The first game of the 2021 season has seen several player game milestones including:

- Brett Jones (BJ) - 300 club games - 203 A Grade and 97 B Grade (plus 2006 A Grade premiership player, B Grade premiership player and A Grade Best & Fairest)
- Daniel Dohnt (DD) - 200 A grade games (plus 45 B Grade games, four A Grade premierships, A Grade Best & Fairest and Best on Ground in 2006 Grand Final)
- Jake Collins - 150 A grade games (plus 27 B Grade games and five time A Grade premiership player)
- Caleb Ritter (Ritts) - 100 A grade games (plus 12 B Grade games)

Co-captain Caleb has played in all five A Grade premierships from 2016 to 2020 and is a product of our juniors. An outstanding effort by Caleb and the rest of the players on their milestones.



Next weekend Chris Heron (Mirrors) will play his 200th A Grade game for South Augusta. He has also played 48 B Grade games, for a total of 248 games. Chris played in the 2006 A Grade premiership 15 years ago, so to see him also involved in last year's 2020 A Grade premiership is recognition of his hard work and commitment. Chris played in the 2006, 2012, 2019 and 2020 A Grade premierships and is known as a fast, hard-hitting wingman and onballer, more recently playing an attacking game in the backline. Congratulations Chris on a distinguished career so far, 300 club games are not far away!



Liam Dodd (Doddsy) also plays his 100th club game and collects the South Augusta pewter mug for his services to the club. Liam has played in B Grade premiership side and is a reliable wingman and defender. Recently absent due to work commitments, it is great to see him back in the game and playing. Liam has played 1 A Grade game and 99 B Grade games. Congratulations for next week Liam.

ANZAC DAY RECOGNISED

After a COVID-19 induced twelve-month delay, SAFC were proud to present our powerful 2019 Anzac Day guernsey, along with notes on all SAFC players who have served their country, to the Port Augusta RSL. Obviously, it was not worn last season (which did not get underway until July) but was proudly worn against Ports in Round 1 on Anzac Eve.

There are several South Augusta players and officials who have served war service including:

Wayne Shepherd and Ray Kohler: Vietnam veterans Wayne Shepherd, who played in the 1972 B Grade Premiership, playing several years and was also trainer for the club; and Ray Kohler who played for the club.

Harry Waterworth Senior: Harry and Colin Waterworth's father, Harry, who was a trainer at the club for several years was enlisted in the Navy in World War II, being involved with some close calls when he survived sinking ships that had been attacked.

John Waterworth: John played for Souths as a Colt and many games in the seniors, playing in the 1995 B grade premiership. He joined the Airforce and served in Afghanistan for 6 months and is currently still in service.

Pat White: Father of past Catering Manager and Life member Trevor White, Pat, was a prisoner of war in World War II, working on the Burma railway. Pat was a sponsor for the club for several years.

GAZZ'S GOSSIP

With Volunteer Recognition Round next month and the 1961, 1991 and 1981 reunions later in the year, Gazz Kittel focusses on a family of players and officials who made an impact in the 1950s and onwards, including trainer Arthur (William) Applebee Snr and Bill Applebee Jnr. Bill played for the club from 1945 to 1957, was a trainer for 15-20 years and volunteered his services for the club for many years. Bill played A Grade and B Grade for the club and his record indicates that he played in six B Grade premierships. Bill is the oldest living player and Life Member of South Augusta and the oldest member to be reported by an umpire! Bill is also a Life member of the Netball Association. Bill and Fay (deceased) are proud parents of Debra and Kym (deceased) with two granddaughters Karly and Renee.

Kym played senior football for South Augusta from 1972 to 1974, having come through the juniors and had a bright future until his life was sadly taken away in a freak car accident.

Cliff Applebee, brother to Bill, played for Souths from 1952 to 1955 when South's guernsey was White with a Red V. Bill's daughter Debra was a talented netballer; and Karly, Bill's granddaughter, played netball for Shamrocks and is also a life member of the Netball Association; and Renee, another granddaughter, played for Shamrocks and Railways. Bill's wife Fay was always available to support the Ladies Committee and would supply home made soup for the counter meals. Bill and Fay's other passion was to attend the Stirling North dances and Bill showed his class on the floor, being a smooth mover.

Arthur Applebee, Bill's father, was born in 1892 in Bowden and died in 1985, aged 92 in Port Augusta. Around 1941, the Highways Department sent him to Stirling North as a Ganger, to maintain the roads from Port Augusta to Wilmington and from Port Augusta halfway to Whyalla. He loved football and played at Dublin for years, then when he shifted to Port Augusta, he was a volunteer with the South Augusta Football Club and he was made a Life Member of the club in 1960.

The Applebees are a remarkable family that lived in Stirling North and the name will always be remembered in the history of the South Augusta Football Club. Bill currently resides in Ramsay Village and gets out on Tuesdays to go down to the Woolworths complex newsagency to meet up with old friends so if you want to meet him just check with his granddaughter Renee on 0422 765 710 - he would love to see you.
