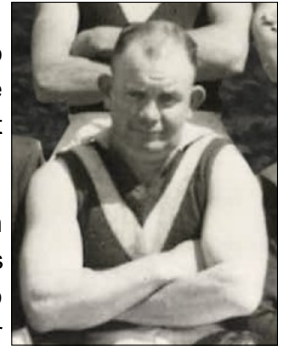




Gazza's GOSSIP

This month's Gary Kittel Gossip discusses several great Life Members of the South Augusta Football Club.

Bert Lehmann: Bert (pictured, right) played senior football for the club from 1934 to 1946, including Premierships in 1938 and 1939. He was Vice Captain for several years. Bert also played football in the Port Augusta representative teams and coached the South League team in 1950. On his retirement, Bert served on the Management Committee, as President in 1952 and Vice President in 1953.



Danny McMahon: Danny was a club stalwart in the early 1980s when he started bingo in the dining room at the old Conroy Street clubrooms, where it regularly had 80-90 players each week. Danny also started the market day raffle and his hard work and dedication to raise money for the club was legendary. In 1987 he was selected as Club Person of the Year in the first year of the award for his outstanding contribution to the club.

Archie Hearne: Archie Hearne senior played for South from 1927 until 1934 and he coached the seconds in 1954. Archie also served as Vice President from 1955 to 1957 and was a trainer and timekeeper from 1956 to 1960. He was a hardworking member over a long period of time.



Robert and Elsie Hearne: Robert Hearne (pictured, far left) was a senior player for the club from 1949 to 1963. He joined the Management Committee in 1969 and was Club Secretary in 1970 and 1971. Robert also served on the Port Augusta Football League and Colts League as a delegate and he coached the Under 18s for a number of years.

Robert's wife Elsie (pictured, right) is also a Life Member, being heavily involved behind the scenes in the catering and organising activities at the club. Elsie served on the Ladies Committee. Their three sons all played for Souths. Robert also played in the 1962

B Grade Premiership which celebrates its 60th Anniversary reunion this year. The team was coached by the great Reg Richards who came from South Adelaide.
