
State Championships.




RITTER BROTHERS






SENIOR GRADES DEBUTS

Cazza's Gossip


This month Gazza focuses on Club Champion Bill Virgo who commenced playing senior football for South Augusta in the late 1950's going on to play 211 league games and numerous representative games. He is a life member of both the club and the SGL. Bill dominated at centre half back and in the ruck, and was regarded as one of the best marks in the league. He represented both Port Augusta and SGL from 1959 until 1969 in games against teams from York Peninsula, SANFL Seconds, Woodville, Broken Hill, and Eyre Peninsula.

During his football career Bill received many invitations to play league football in Adelaide but resisted all offers. Bill's love of the game saw him coaching juniors for five years as well as being Captain Coach of the league side in 1973 and 1974.

He won the Madigan Medal twice and the Transcontinental Medal in 1967 and 1969 and in 1973 was the runner up in the Transcontinental Medal in 1963 and Bill won the Mobil Award and in between was the Phillip Morris Award winner in 1964 which was a memorable year for the club as Bill was a member of the premiership team.

In 2003 the Port Augusta Football League selected a Ruby Team selecting the best twenty-two footballers to have played in Port Augusta between 1961 and 2001. Bill was selected at centre half back in his team. He was inducted into the Port Augusta League Hall of Fame in 2005 and into the South Augusta Hall of Fame as one of the select legends. 

Connor Rozee update: Connor has started the season well and was named best against Essendon. He has flourished under the captaincy and continues to impress.


Congratulations to Central Augusta junior Kane McAuliffe who made his AFL debut for Richmond during Gather Round another great Port Augusta junior product.


