INTRODUCING PlayHQ

The AFL has chosen to change competition platforms from Sporting Pulse / Sports TG / Game Day to PlayHQ. We are attempting to get on top of this new platform so we can issue email invitations for players, volunteers and officials to register for the 2022 season.

SANFL fees (up \$5 from 2021 to \$20 seniors / \$15 juniors) and club membership will be paid when registering. All 2021 players from all grades down to U9 will be sent an email from PlayHQ to enable them to register for the 2022 season.

SANFL Players Registration Payment of \$20 seniors / \$15 juniors must be paid when registering on PlayHQ. Every player at every club will have to pay this so it is basically no pay no play. This is NOT a club or SGL imposed fee. It does NOT replace club membership.
