CRICKET UPDATE

The A Grade have made it through to the Grand Final with an exciting win against Quorn in the Semi Final last weekend. After a poor batting performance for the second week in a row, the team only made 106, and the 40 run partnership between Marcus Gill and Rowan Irvine (both in the 30s) set up a half competitive total, and in the end won the game. The bowlers once again came through, dismissing Quorn for 66 - Craig Shirley 4 wickets, Clayton Parkinson 2 wickets, Driscoll 1 wicket, Ben Trewartha 2 wickets and Vater 2 wickets in a consistent display. In the Grand Final they must improve their batting as they may not get away with that again.

In the B Grade, both teams will play off in the Preliminary Final and one of them will play in the Grand Final in two weeks.

The Under 17s lost last week but still have a double chance to make the final; and the Under 14s, who had only won one game for the year before the finals, won its first final and will play in the Preliminary Final, with coaches Yates and Freebairn very happy with the unexpected result.
