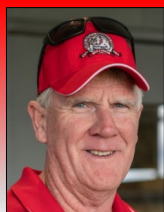

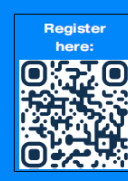

Gazza's GOSSIP

In this Month's Newsletter Gary Kittel focuses on South Augusta Junior Colts history.

South Augusta has a tremendous history of success in its juniors and this leads on to senior grades success. Thus, juniors have always been a priority. The club prides itself in its coaching staff from U7 upwards and has excellent success. Ray Miller and John McElligott were the first ex-senior players to take on the role of junior coaches. They were instrumental in the early development of many young footballers at the club. Other coaches to serve the club well in the capacity of junior coaches for long periods of time include David Williams, Mark McKell, Robert Laube, Craig Ritter, Gary Grantham, Peter Trewartha and Graeme Williams. These coaches developed some very good footballers over the years including premiership players, SANFL and AFL players.

David Williams had been the backbone to the junior coaches for many years and has been recognised with the Life Membership at the league level, club level, Port Augusta FL Hall of Fame. David was also inducted into South Augusta Legend and Hall of Fame. Following on from Ray and John were some great South names, Bill Virgo, Mick Vanvacas and Ray Hanrahan who coached colts into 1960's.

In the 1970's Graham Pidgeon was to coach the senior colts to a premiership in 1970, coaching for three years and together with Graeme William's, Adrian Elliott, Archie Hearne, Colin Waterworth, and Ian "Moose" Pickford the colts grades were expanded and more juniors were playing for the club than ever before ensuring the future of the senior grades. Jeff Shillabeer, Greg McAtee and Brian Shillabeer were also coaches during the latter part of the 1970's developing teams that would create successful senior players in the early 1980's when the A Grade Premierships occurred.

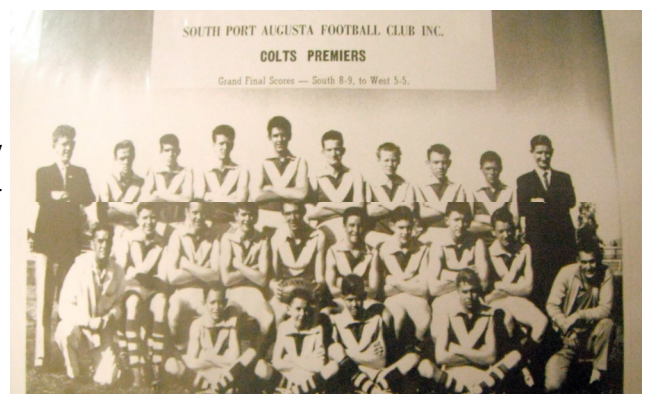
The extra grades developed during the 1970's and extra fundraising was required. The Red and White Ball was a great fundraiser for the club during this time, organised by junior coaches such as Graeme Williams, Adrian Elliot, Robert Archie Hearne, Ian Pickford and Colin Waterworth, who was to go on to be a Life Member of the Port Augusta Colts Association and served for many years on the South Augusta Colts Committee. Robert "Archie" Hearne was to coach the senior colts for several years.

Others to be involved during the period include David Winter, Kym "Kelly" Grantham, Ray Hanrahan, Peter Rivers, Gary Grantham (5 Years), Brenton Hall and Mark McKell. Mark started coaching under 11's in 1985, after being a trainer for the club for 2 years. He completed 13 years of coaching junior and senior grades until 2008 and finished with premierships and a coach of many senior footballers. He is also a Life Member for the club and has volunteered his services for the club in some capacity for over 20 years.

Craig Ritter started coaching U11's in 1996 and has been involved with the club as a junior coach for 15 years, coaching junior grades from U9 to U15. He also achieved several junior premierships, is a Life Member, serving as secretary for the Colts Committee and a fundraiser, organising the hot dog trailer for several years. See you next month.

CRICKET FLASH BACK

A Grade position 5th

Captain Jarrod Waterworth. South lose several players from last year's Grand final team including David Allanson, Graham Barton and Paul Trzeciak. Iain Elliott also travelled to Adelaide to play district cricket. Despite this the team finished half a game out of the finals. New players included teachers Dave Murray and Mick Shaw.

The C Grade wins the Premiership after several years with Captain Brian Pretty at the helm. The B Grade finish fourth. The club does not have an U16 team and the Under 14s finish well down the ladder in 7th spot.

In A Grade the best batting aggregate included Robert Rozee 577 runs, Iain Elliott 537, Mark Shirley 333, Greg Minney 280 and Dave Murray 280. In the bowling Jarrod Waterworth took 35 wickets, Mark Shirley 23, Robert Rozee and Michael Shaw 16 each.

In the B Grade David Clarke was best with the bat with 239 runs and best bowler with 41 wickets followed by Damian Farr with 19, Craig McAllister 16 and Geoff Turner 15.

In the C Grade Brian Pretty was best with 375 runs, David Shillabeer 308 and in the bowling Doug Rozee 17 wickets, David Shillabeer 21 and Jason Waterworth 14. Jarrod Waterworth won the Les Favell trophy for the best player in the Country Carnival and makes the Carnival Team of the Year together with Robert Rozee

WHERE ARE THEY NOW

Andy Coulter was seen at a local pub in Adelaide recently. Andy transferred to Port Augusta as a teacher and played for the club from 1984 to 1989, a total of 51 A Grade games and 39 B Grade games. Andy played in the A Grade final in 1984 where South lost to Sollies. Andy played either on the ball, wing or in the forward line and was well respected by the opposition as a dangerous player. Andy was also a great cricketer, although playing for the wrong team Redsox !. Andy eventually moved to the Clare region for work and is retired in the Adelaide area. 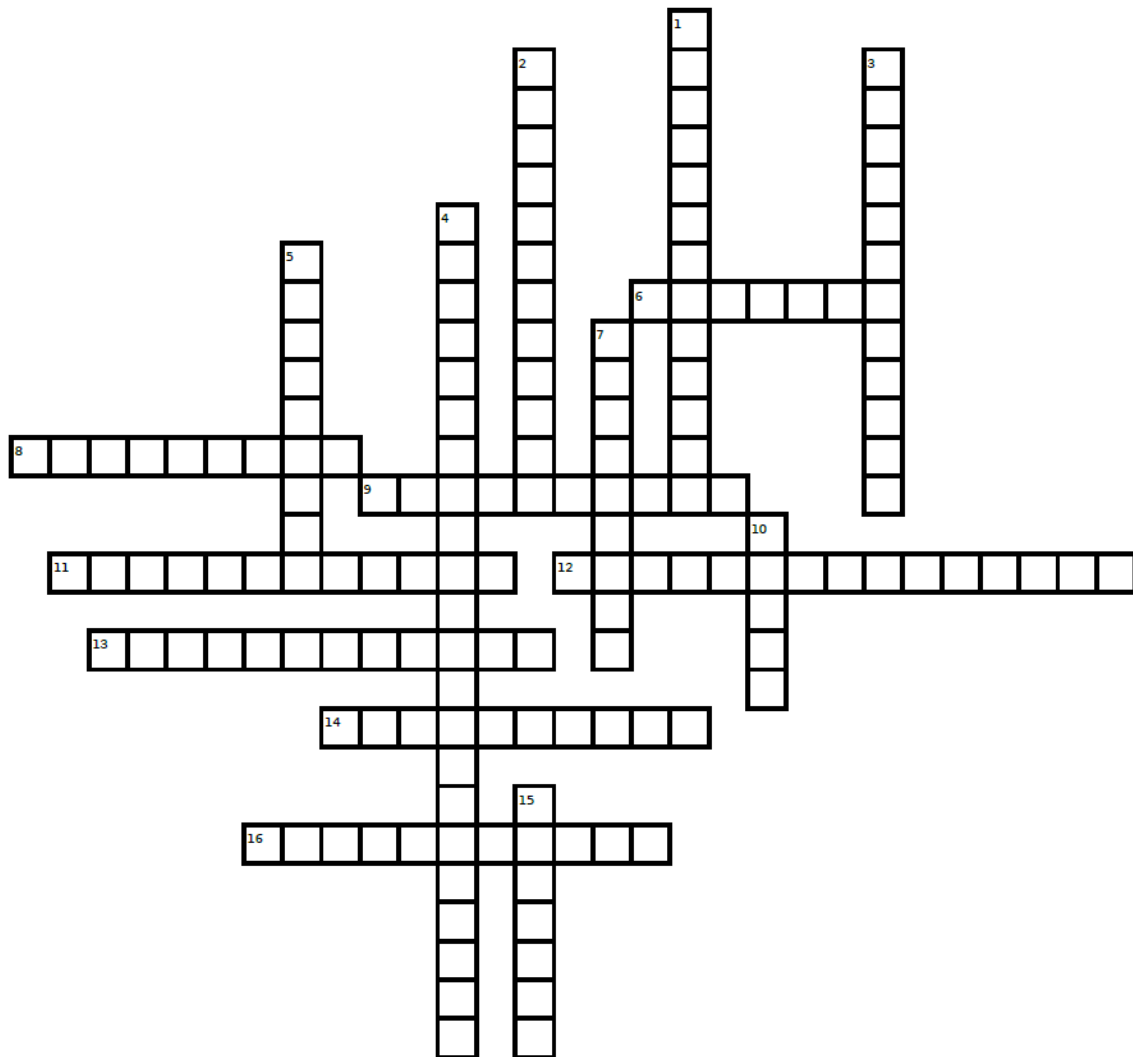

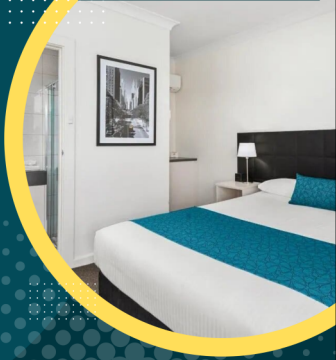
