FROM THE PRESIDENT

One such victim was the Kangaroo Island Football League's reigning premiers, the Western Districts Saints. They lost 50 years of team photos, club records, memorabilia and other such history. 2020 sees the introduction by SANFL of a Players Registration Payment of \$15 seniors/\$10 juniors which must be paid when registering. It does NOT replace club membership which ALL senior players are required to take out and all junior families are requested to take out.

CRICKET UPDATE

The A Grade haven't had the best of times lately with losses against bottom teams West and Central; but came back well with a good win against Quorn in their last game. They must improve their batting if they wish to feature in the finals race, but they are confident of a Top 2 finish with that win.

Will Waterworth has 234 runs and Craig Shirley 173 runs on the "My Cricket" website; and Craig Shirley has 21 wickets and Ben Trewartha 17 wickets. Let's get behind the lads in the lead up to the finals.

The two B Grade teams are in first and fourth positions on the table and both have an opportunity to play in the finals. Kurt Reynolds has 25 wickets and newcomer Rhys Bavington has 14 wickets. Best with the bat so far includes old timers Anthony Freebairn with 296 runs (including 101), James Harrison 290 runs and Wes Yates 283 runs.

In the Under 17s, South are in second spot behind Quorn with Vaughan Yates having taken 6 wickets, Tirbhavan Singh and Ryan Gilbert both with 4 wickets; and with the bat Rex Waterworth has 166 runs and Mitchell McInnis 61 runs.

WHERE ARE THEY NOW - STEPHEN BROOKS

Did you know a member of the 1983/84 South Augusta Cricket A Premiership team was awarded a Conspicuous Service Medal (CSM) in Australia Day honours in recent years?

Stephen Brooks transferred and worked in a local bank at Port Augusta in the early 1980s when he played cricket at Souths and was a member of the victorious team. Stephen left the town after a short stint and joined the Army Reserve in 1994, later to become a chaplain and serve in overseas postings including Afghanistan and Kuwait. Stephen was awarded the honour for his tireless commitment and dedication to pastoral care and religious ministry.

When Chaplain Brooks learned he was being awarded a CSM he was humbled by

the praise. "It was also an acknowledgement of the wonderful support I have received from my wife and two children."
