MATT DOWNEY LEAVES THE CLUB

Sadly, we have to farewell five-time Premiership ruckman Matt Downey. Matt joined the club in 2016 while working as a scaffolder with All States Scaffolding at the power station. He has played in the last five South Augusta A Grade Premierships and played 82 A Grade games from 2016-2020.

In his first year in 2016 he won the Kittel Cup, the trophy for the A Grade Fairest and Best, played SGL representative football, was rated second best player in the Grand Final and won the Best Team Man Award.

In 2017 Matt won his second A Grade Fairest and Best, Best Team Man and was runner-up in the Madigan Medal to Darcy Kildea. He was rated second best player in the Grand Final win.

In 2018 he was A Grade Fairest and Best runner-up, runner-up to Aziel Stuart in the Madigan Medal, won the Best Team Man Trophy and the Franko Farr Memorial Trophy. Matt was rated amongst the best five players in the Grand Final win.

In 2019 he was awarded the A Grade Most Dedicated Trophy and was rated amongst the top five players in the Grand Final win.

In 2020 he was awarded the A Grade Most Consistent award and was rated in the top five players in the Grand Final win.

Arguably one of the best ruckmen in the club's history, Matt will be leaving his role as a Correctional Officer at the Port Augusta Gaol to pursue a career as a police officer in the Northern Territory.
