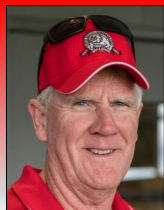

The Under 18s are currently in fifth spot with four wins and seven losses. The last few games will decide if they will play finals. William Newbery leads the goalkicking with 37 goals.

The Under 13s are in top spot with eight wins, being undefeated so far. Best players most mentioned include Coheyn Patrick (6 times), Zech Amos and Oscar Williams (4 times each). Leading goalkickers are Zech Amos with 7 goals, Jamahl Scrutton with 6 goals and Hamish Blinman with 5 goals.

The Under 11s are in top spot with six wins and four losses. Players most mentioned in the best players include Leo McInnis (8 times), Nate Lukich (6), Eddy Heron (7) and Jamahl Scrutton (5). Leo McInnis is the leading goalkicker with 10 goals.

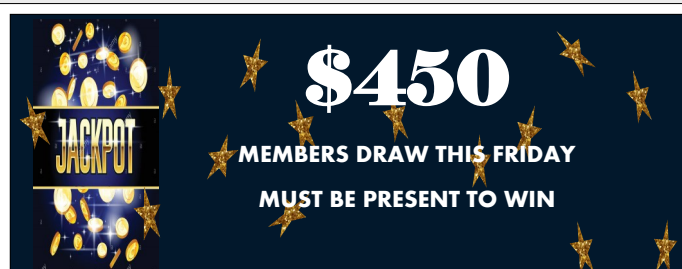

Gazza's GOSSIP

This month Gazza focuses on South Augusta's brilliant Indigenous footballers who have played for the club over the years, which is fitting with the Indigenous Round coming up vs Sollies on 14th August.

A summary of some of the players who have impressed are:

Christian Reid - Player and Life Member who commenced his senior career in 1997. Played over 200 games, including the 2000 and 2006 A Grade Premierships. Represented Port Augusta League and the SGL. Selected in the PAFL Team of the Year. Life Member of the SGL. Coach Pat Hynes said that Christian was a skilful player who never played a poor game.

Jimmy Anderson - Playing member of the 1964 A Grade Premiership side. Recruited from the Darwin Buffaloes, named in best players in the finals. Was a champion centreman, full of dash and opponents realised this when they clashed. In his early career he was recruited to the West Perth Football Club. Played three games and returned to Darwin and still got 9 votes in the WA Sandover Medal. Jimmy's grandson Jed Anderson plays for North Melbourne. Was named in the NT Centenary Team.

Fabian Davey - A member of the famous Davey Family. Played in the 1993 and 1994 A Grade Premiership South Augusta sides. A brilliant and skilful player, known as Legend and was a curse of opposing teams. Is a hero in Port Lincoln and has a street named after him. Played for Souths from 1991-1995.

Shaun McLennan - Recruited in 1993 and was a member of the 1993 A Grade Premiership side. 1993 Fairest and Best, Madigan Medallist in 1993 and was a skilful, brilliant centreman.

Keiron Keeler - Recruited in 1999 when Souths lost to Port in the Grand final by 17 points. Named in the best players that game. A Grade Fairest and Best. Won Transcontinental Medal and was third in the Madigan Medal. In 2000 South won the Grand Final and Keiron won the Madigan Medal.

Kriston Thompson - A 3-time premiership player in 2018-2020. Has twice won the Fairest and Best Kittel Cup donated by the Kittel family. Is highly regarded by the players and the club and has a long and bright future. Is a role model throughout the schooling system with the younger generation. In 2020 he was awarded the Transcontinental Medal.

Clayton Milera - A 5-time Premiership player in 2012, 2016, 2017, 2018 and 2020. In the 2020 final he kicked 7 goals and was named Best on Ground.

Aziel Stuart - A 4-time premiership player in 2016-2019 and winner of the Madigan Medal. A speedy wingman with great disposal.

Lionel Brown - Played full forward in four A Grade Premierships in 2016, 2017, 2018 and 2020.

Gary Warren - A 4-time premiership player in 2017-2020. A solid build footballer who puts in a consistent game.

Jarryd Warren - Played in A Grade Premierships from 2018-2020.

Jaylon Wingfield - A 3-time premiership player in 2016, 2019 and 2020.

Bradley Amos - Played for South from 2003-2011, 2006 A Grade Premiership player. Kicked over 100 goals in one season, the only player in the club's history to do so. Was a mentor and role model with the indigenous youth. Is the father of Aziel Stuart, Madigan Medallist. Other members of the Amos family who played for South were Casey Amos 2011, Michael Amos 1999-2000 and Tim Amos 2011 to current.

Kahran McKenzie - One of the two indigenous players to play in five premierships 2016-2020 - a significant effort.

Billy-Jo Russell - Played in three A Grade Premierships 2016-2018. Missed the 2020 Grand Final due to a shoulder injury. Excellent team member and proud footballer.

Waye Family - Tyrone was a member of last year's B Grade Premiership and named in best players. Other members of the Waye family to play for South include Doug Waye 1971; Ian Waye Jnr 1998-2003; Ian Waye Snr 1970-1973; John Waye 1998-2002; and Robert Waye 1999- 2004.

Wingfield Family - Members to play include Glen Wingfield 2007; Jaylon 2008-2020; Lyle 2003, and Tyrone 2007-2011.

Coulthard Family - Members to play long careers for Souths include Warren and David Coulthard.

Fuschtei Family - Ronald, Eddie and Jo Fuschtei all played for Souths, with Ronald playing in several A Grade premierships.

Aitken Family - Kyle and Kareem Aitken play for Souths, Kyle has played in several A Grade premierships

Michael Witchen - Played for South from 1998-2004 and was a B Grade SGL Medallist.

Milera Family - Members who have played for South include Clayton; Ian 1996; Josh 2007-2011; Kevin 1996; Kyle 2004; Lionel 1996-1997; and Lyndon 2007-2011.

Dadleh Family - From the Marree Football Club, included Ken Dadleh Snr 1970-1971; Ken Jnr 2000-2001; Darryl Dadleh 1979-1981, who was a member of the 1981 A Grade Premiership team; and another member from the Marree team, William Butch Bejah 1968.

Anthony Anno - Player and Life Member, played 209 League and 110 Seconds games from 1988-2008. Fairest and Best for the Club. A Grade Captain 1998-2003, premiership player in 1993, 1994 and 2000. Life member of the SGL and nominee for the Port Augusta Ruby Anniversary team 1961-2001.

Get along to honour these past and present players and other indigenous members at our Indigenous Round vs Solomontown on Saturday 14th August.

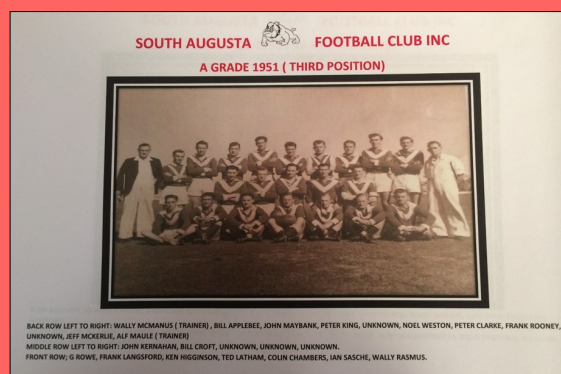

THE 1950s - THE CLUB LOOKS FOR A HOME

South's had limited success in the 1950's, not winning a Premiership during this period and losing six Grand Finals. This must have been disappointing to the players who played during this era, although they were known as a hard, competitive club during this period.

In 1950 South lost the A Grade Grand Final to West Augusta 13.12 to 9.8, with best players for South's being Brian Fountain, Ted Latham, Colin Chalmers, Peter Clarke, Norm Brearley, Elwyn Rowe and Rex Gellard. South Augusta did however win the B grade premiership that year under Coach Archie Hearne. Bert Lehman was the A Grade coach in 1950 with Ted Latham taking over for 2 years in 1951. Brian Fountain won the Fairest and Best and was a good player in the early 1950's.

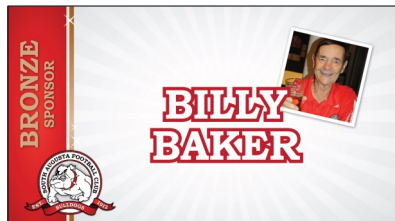
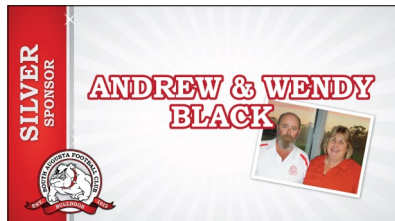
