RETURN TO FOOTBALL NOTES

Vice President, Nick Heron, attended the SANFL webinar recently and had a few notes to share with members.

A lot of information is on the SA Community Football website. It is being updated regularly and has many resources.

The requirement of counting spectators at a venue has been removed. There is now a calculator that is used to determine numbers. It doesn't include buildings or clubrooms, etc as they are covered by other guidelines.

- Distancing guidelines are to be practiced.
- The current 500 limit on spectators is for the leagues that are commencing the weekend of June 27th. These restrictions will be lifted by the following weekend of July 4th (calculator to be used).
- There is a short educational video on spectator management available at sanfl.com.au/returntoplay.
- Showers will be permitted and numbers in the change room will be increased, but ONLY essential people are allowed to be in the room (eg: players, coach, trainer). No family or Committee members, etc unless classed as essential.
- There is now a COVIDSAFE CLEANING CHECKSHEET.
- There will be posters made up for key messaging around hygiene and social distancing.

TRAINING

- Attendance records are being kept for EVERYONE that is on site. This is not a requirement but a measure that we will have in place.
- We have people providing sanitation (eg: supplying hand sanitiser) to all.
- Social distancing is being exercised.
- There were facilities open, but as mentioned that will change from July 3

MATCH DAY

- The protocols in place for training will be reflected on Match Day. There will be hand sanitiser and we need someone to be at the door with the sanitiser to capture people.
- All posters, etc will be in place.
- Players and support staff will have been informed about what is expected of them. '

BILLY'S CORNER

The late Bob Hammond was an icon of SA football – as an administrator, as well as a coach and a player, and his record has been heralded across many platforms since his passing last week. During the 1960s Hammond also had a strong connection to community football and while working as the manager of the Dunlop Tyre Service in Port Pirie, he was Captain-Coach of the Ports Bulldogs Football Club in Port Pirie across both the 1966 and 1967 seasons. The connection with South Augusta was that he coached Port when they defeated South in the 1967 Grand Final at Port Pirie.
