FOOTBALL REPORT

The A Grade currently sit one game clear in fourth place, with 4 wins and 5 losses. The Top 5 players mentioned on Game Day so far include Kriston Thompson and Azriel Stuart 5 times; Caleb Ritter, Darcy Kildea and Ethan Reid 4 times. Billy-Jo Russell and Jake Collins have both kicked 11 goals.

The B Grade are in second spot (by percentage from top spot), with 7 wins and 2 losses. Players most mentioned in the best players include Brett Jones and Mitchell French 4 times; Byron Taylor, Connor McMillan, Ethan Gade and Marcus Kerin 3 times. Jack Menzies has kicked 8 goals.

The Under 18s are currently in fifth spot, with 3 wins and 6 losses and are still a good chance of making the finals if they keep the consistency going after a close loss to West. Players most mentioned in the Top 5 players include Dalton Gade, Micheal Collins 5 times; Harry Bolitho and Hudson Brazell 4 times. Lenny Hoffman has kicked 10 goals.

The Under 15s are sitting in fifth spot (one win behind fourth spot) with 2 wins and 6 losses. Players most mentioned in the best players include Robert Naylor and Ronan Coombe 5 times; and Jack Franklin 4 times. Joe Clancy has the most goals with 12.

The Under 13s are in top spot with 5 wins. The best players most mentioned include Zech Amos, Ryleigh Whitehead, Oscar Williams and Coheyn Patrick. Most goals kicked are Zech Amos with 5; and Addyson Di Paolo and Sydney Coombe with 4.

The Under 11s are in top spot with 5 wins and 2 losses. Players most mentioned in the best players include Leo McInnis 5 times; Nate Lukich and Eddy Heron 4 times; Wyatt Shillabeer and Noah Kruger 3 times. Most goals is Leo McInnis with 7.

THE 1990s - HYNES AT THE HELM

The 1990s proved a successful decade with the club making the four Grand Finals with two premierships and the B Grade winning three premierships.

The 1990 season was again an average year for the A Grade, finishing 7th under popular coach Brian Beinke. However, the B Grade under coach Peter Rivers won the premiership, defeating Central 14.7 to 8.5. South recruited Roxby Downs players Steve Dryburgh and Paul Niekel with Steve having a great year winning the A Grade Fairest and Best.

Pat Hynes took over as A Grade coach in 1991 and took the club to the Grand Final, losing to Central Augusta 14.16 to 13.8. The B Grade won the Grand Final against Central Augusta, 8.13 to 9.3, again under Peter Rivers. The club had recruited new players in Fabian Davey, Martin Flanagan and Shaun McLennan and had made an excellent recovery only to stumble at the last hurdle. In an amazing game during the year South Augusta defeated Sollies 16.00 to 14.11 by 1 point, with Gary Kernahan kicking the late winning goal from an impossible angle.

GAZZ'S GOSSIP

This month Gazza discusses Richard Oakey, a previous coach of South Augusta. In 1965, history shows that Richard was recruited from Norwood where he was the leading ruck and Bob Oakey the leading rover. Richard coached South seconds to win the premiership in 1965 while he was playing A Grade. He also represented the SGL and also made the Team of the Year that year.

In 1966 Richard was appointed A Grade coach with the team just finishing out of the finals in the 12 team competition. It was a competitive year for the club with 10 wins and that year. He also won the Transcontinental Medal for the best Port Augusta player in the league. South Augusta players to play for Port Augusta that year included Gill Schupelius, Ray Hanrahan, Bill Virgo, Bruce Curtis, Richard Oakey, Sam Moore and Geoff Fullerton.

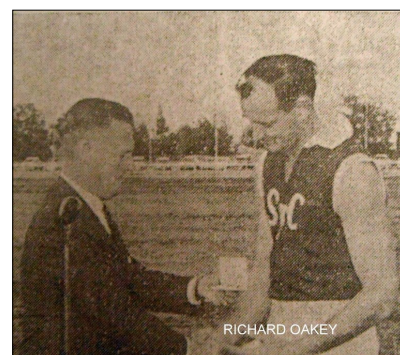
Richard spent his youth in Port Augusta where he attended the Westside Primary School, before going onto Port Augusta High School where he was head prefect. He played football for West Augusta before moving to Adelaide to play for Norwood where he was a first class ruckman. Sadly, South lost a player of great experience in 1967 when he returned to West Augusta to coach where he took them to three premierships in row. Richard married a Quorn girl called Marlene Jones and they had a son called Peter and daughter Brenda, and they are now retired in Gawler.

Richard did not show his skills just as a footballer as he showed his talents by being involved in the sport of trotting. He trained and owned horses and he had successes at Port Augusta and Globe Derby Park tracks.

FOOTNOTE FLASHBACK - DO YOU REMEMBER?

How many South Augusta supporters remember when the boundary umpire carried a white handkerchief tucked on the top of their shorts when they didn't have a whistle. When the ball went out of bounds they would pull out the white cloth and wave it above their head to signal the ball had gone out. They would place the handkerchief on the spot where the ball went out. To continue the play he would throw the ball back over his head to the ruck contest. Then he would continue on his merry way around the boundary line! Times have changed.
