FOOTBALL UPDATE

Round 7 saw another disappointing A Grade loss this time to Central (11.12 to 7.8).

Best players were Caleb Ritter, Ethan Gade, Patrick Kennedy, Zechariah Amos, Rowan Irvine and Trent Ritter (3 goals).

B Grade lost 60 points to 28 and the U18s lost 100pts to 16pts with the best players Joe Clancy, Anthony Truong, Bryce McKenzie, Jack Franklin, Riley Whitehead.

Round 8 welcomed the latest A Grade debutant in Mitchell Cavanagh to the club. On the same day we welcomed back retired veteran Jake Collins who made up the B Grade numbers in game number 203 (165A+ 38B).

The A Grade had a solid win over arch rivals West Augusta and so recorded their second win of the season. Final scores were South 13.8 to West 9.9. Best players were Sam Maule, Lenny Hoffmann, Ethan Reid, Rowan Irvine, Caleb Ritter and goal kickers Craig Shirley and Trent Ritter 3 each and new player Mitchell Cavanagh 2 goals.

With 9 rounds to go the A Grade are in fifth spot with 2 wins and 6 losses but just 2% outside the four. Finals are well and truly within reach. The B Grade lost by 22 points and the U18s lost by 185 points to both remain in 6th position.

The U15s defeated West by 89 points to be in 2nd position and the U13s defeated West by 31 points to be in 2nd position whilst the U11's defeated West by 34 points to be in top spot.

The U14 girls defeated North Whyalla by 22 points to be in 2nd position on the ladder.

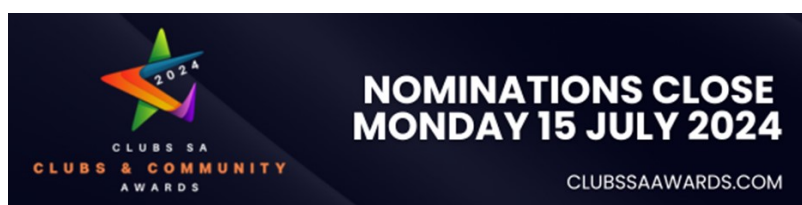

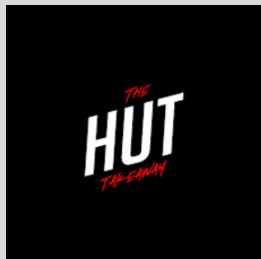

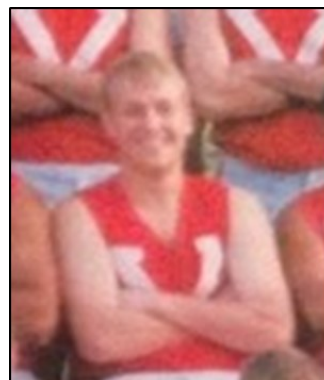
MEMO FROM THE SANFL RE COMMUNITY FOOTBALL BEHAVIOUR 2024

- 1) (NB..slightly edited from original version which was published for a statewide audience)
- 2) "SANFL reminds you of the importance of behaviour management to ensure that match day environments are safe and enjoyable for all. Recently, there have been numerous accounts of unacceptable behaviour including racial vilification/homophobic slurs/verbal and physical abuse of umpires and spectators/increased yellow and red cards for players/on-field violence/inappropriate crowd behaviour. SANFL and each League sets clear behavioural expectations for all participants, coaches, officials, parents and spectators. It is apparent that these standards are not being upheld, requiring stronger actions.
- 5) UMPIRES
- 6) Umpire abuse remains a major issue. They must be allowed to perform their duties in a safe and supportive environment. Threatening and abusive behaviour towards umpires is completely unacceptable. **Without umpires there is no football.** The controlling body can charge spectators, coaches, players etc. who use abusive, insulting or obscene language towards an umpire. If found guilty they could face a suspension from attending or playing football. **Recent suspensions have ranged from 4 weeks, 7 months, 13 months and 24 months.**
- 7) COACHES, PLAYERS, SPECTATORS, PARENTS
- 8) SANFL has seen a rise in player and spectator penalties. Incidents such as on-field melees, abysmal crowd behaviour or abuse will not be tolerated. SAFC coaches, players, officials and members must set the example, be role models for clubs and their behaviour must reflect this.
- 9) MOVING FORWARD
- 10) As requested by SANFL we at SAFC have addressed our players, coaches, members, and supporters about acceptable/not acceptable behaviours and reminded them that every negative act is observed by others including children. We at SAFC have taken steps to lead change. Failure to change can see the loss of volunteers/respect/players/sponsorship/revenue and damage the SAFC brand and reputation. We must and will continue to strive to do better. It is ultimately up to each of us to uphold and drive positive standards at ALL times. We need to remember that it is a game".

Robert Rozee: Robert was a champion player for South, playing senior football from 1979-1993 achieving a total of 200 S.G.L games. Robert played in the 1981 A Grade Premiership team before travelling to Adelaide where he played for South Adelaide's seconds and seniors. He was captain of the South Adelaide seconds.

Robert played all his junior football at Souths, including senior premierships before progressing to SANFL football. When playing for South Augusta A Grade he was Runner up Fairest and Best on several occasions. Robert coached the South Augusta seconds in 1984 and the seniors in 1987 and 1988 where the team made the Preliminary Final. Robert represented Port Augusta and S.G.L. over several years. Robert also excelled in cricket for South Augusta. Robert is a Life Member and was inducted into the Hall of Fame last year. Robert's son Connor is current captain of Port Adelaide in the A.F.L.

Doug Rozee: Doug a brother to Robert played over 300 senior games and 200 S.G.L. for South Augusta. He played from 1979-1994 having played in A Grade Premierships in 1981 and 1994. Doug played in a variety of positions initially in the forward lines and finishing his career in the back lines.

Doug also excelled in cricket for South's and is a life member of the Football Club.

Ron Rozee: Ron was an uncle to Robert and Doug and is a Life Member of SAFC. He served on the Management Committee for a number of years. He was President in 1967 and Vice President for some time and a club and Port Augusta team selector. Ron is also a Life Member of the Port Augusta Harness Trotting Club. Ron's wife was a member of the Ladies Committee for many years.

Kevin Rozee: Brother to Ron and father to Robert and Doug and grandfather to Connor. Kevin played for South's from 1939-1946.

Sad to hear the news that Faye Schwab had recently passed away. Faye was a great supporter of the club and before moving from Port Augusta served as Treasurer for 4 years from 1986 to 1989. Husband Colin was Vice President in 1990 and President in 1991. Condolences to Colin and Faye's family and friends at this sad time.

Sad to hear that past player Greg McAtee passed away recently aged 72. Greg played off and on from 1967 to 1980 and was a member of the 1979 B Grade Premiership team. He played 48 A Grade games and 80 B Grade games for a total of 128 senior games. Greg played mainly in the ruck and was a big supporter of the club after he retired. Greg could often be seen at race meetings as a bookmaker before his illness and worked in the administration field at ETSA when he was living in Port Augusta. He also served the SGL as an official during the 1970's. Greg was a consistently good player in the A Grade, later playing in the B's towards the end of his career. In 1979 he was named in the best players most weeks and particularly in the finals when he was named third best in the B Grade Grand Final against Willsden. The club offers its condolences to Greg's family and friends at this sad time.
