FROM THE PRESIDENT

Due to the air of uncertainty, this is quite a difficult piece to write this month. What a hectic time it has been with numerous Zooms and updated information from various bodies. By the time you read this, things may have changed again. Keeping members, sponsors, players and parents connected with OUR club over the past few months via social media, email etc has been a priority. Any suggestions to engage our people during this isolation time are very welcome.

In summary:

- 1) The SGL season will only get underway IF clubs can re-open and crowds are allowed into matches so costs can be met.
- 2) The PACFL season may get underway even without spectators as it is obviously much cheaper to run.
- 3) Restricted training could have started last Monday 18th May IF clubs have ticked the large number of boxes required by the SANFL / SGL / PA Council. Players and clubs may face penalties from SAPOL / SANFL / SGL for any breaches (see attachment).
- 4) Currently any "training" is for personal fitness only and must abide by SAPOL laws.
- 5) No news yet on clubs re-opening but Clubs SA has sent out eleven pages of checklists for us to consider when the time comes. Thus your committee has been working diligently to shape what SAFC is going to do / look like post COVID-19
- 6) Your committee has been entrusted with very important roles. The most important is to ensure the survival of our great club into the future. Thanks to those who have sent messages of support over the past weeks. Please support us in any way you can.

Please stay safe for the duration of this event. We will continually monitor the situation and keep you informed of any updates regarding club re-opening, season start dates etc.

SGL NEWS

As a result of the last SGL meeting held on 11th May the following points were discussed:

- Three weeks minimum pre-season is required, which may involve a weekend round robin carnival acting as pre-season trial games
- The season will only go ahead if at least ten games can be played AND spectators are allowed into the ground in order to meet match day costs.
- 3) If a ten game season can commence by 27th June, then the finals series will be played as normal.
- 4) A later start MAY involve extending the season into late September or October. The start-up of summer sports will be a factor in any such extension and may prevent this.
- 5) If 2020 is totally lost then it will become the 2021 program to maintain the 5 year cycle of the fixtures.

The South Augusta Vice Presidents Club has partnered with the Australian Sports Foundation to enable members to get a tax deduction benefit in 2020 - and if you make your donation before 30th June, you can claim it on your tax. BILLY'S CORNER

Patrick "Paddy" O'Keefe first played with South Augusta A Grade in 1953, after moving to Port Augusta for employment from the Kilburn Football Club. Gary Kittel indicated that the O'Keefe family were heavily involved with the Kilburn Club and even had the gates to the oval named after them.

Paddy wore number 14 and played over 60 games spanning six seasons in the A Grade, and was a high flying forward, even kicking 12 goals in one game. During his playing career he played in four Grand Finals, losing all of them to arch-rivals Central Augusta. He was mentioned in the best players in three of these games and the one-point loss in 1954 would have been heartbreaking for him and the team as they had not won a Premiership since 1942. Because of his attack on the ball Paddy was prone to injury and he retired in 1958 going on to be a well-respected and highly regarded golfer and bowler in the town. He also served on the Committee and continued to support the club.



He would have been proud of what his grandson Mark Fuller has achieved at Centrals. Paddy passed away in December 2019 and laid to rest on 7th January 2020. The club offers its condolences to his family and respects the contribution he has made to the club during his playing career and afterwards as a supporter.
