



WANT TO BE PART OF A SUB COMMITTEE FOR A GRANT TO GET MORE FEMALE FOOTBALL PLAYERS AT THE CLUB?

Recently we received a \$4,500 grant called "Power of Her" from the Office of Sport and Recreation which aims to increase female participation into football. The grant is to be used to complete the project via spending on:

- training equipment, uniforms, travel
- shorts and socks for new players
- indigenous recognition round and guernseys
- cultural awareness night etc

The project outcomes are as follows:

Partnering with local schools and Salvation Army, increase the participation of female players with a focus on indigenous females for the club.

Target: 20 new female players with a minimum of 10 indigenous female players. Create and enhance a sense of belonging and purpose by engaging local club indigenous elders and community leaders to connect and mentor new and potential female players.

Provide cultural awareness training to players to ensure a safe and welcoming environment for existing and new female players and participants.

Recognise female indigenous players who have played at the club in the past and establish an indigenous themed football day at the South Augusta Football Club. We are currently in the process of forming a Steering Committee for the project and would like you to be involved if you can. We plan to have our first meeting at the club next month with the date yet to be determined. Great to see a few ex-Southies involved with Premierships in 2024. Vinny Urbancic, who played in 4 A Grade Premierships and 1 B Grade Premiership from 2016-2020 won another Premiership with Kilburn this year.

Lawrence Bradley Brown who played in the 2020 A Grade Premiership won another one with West Gambier.

Caleb Edmead, son of 1981 and 1983 A Grade Premiership player Derek, won 4 in a row with Two Wells.

Darren Shillabeer, A Grade Premiership player in 2006 was Captain Coach of Myponga-Sellicks who broke a 40-year premiership drought with a thrilling one-point victory over Victor Harbor in the Great Southern Football League (GSFL) Grand Final

The Myponga Sellicks Mudlarks had to do it the hard way, winning four finals in a row on their way to a fourth 'A' grade flag. They kicked three goals to one in the final term to win 10.8 (68) to 9.13 (67). In his first season at the club playing-coach Darren Shillabeer kicked three goals and in the process brought up his 100th major for the season.

Sympathies to families and friends of several people who have had involvement with the club in some way and have died in the last month including:

- Marlene Bellman, sister of past A Grade Coach Brian Bienke and aunty of past player Bryan Bienke.
- Shirley Manning, mother of past South Augusta Cricket Captain Kevin Manning and the Manning sons who have been great sportspeople in the town over the years.
- Joan Gellard, 95 years of age and wife of past President Rex Gellard and heavily involved with the Ladies Committee during the early 1960s.
- Frank Dalla Santa who has been a club sponsor for several years also passed away in October.

It was a huge shock to learn of the passing of ex player, Premiership coach, mentor and huge influence for many of our players over two decades. We send our thoughts and commiserations to Jess and Jared and all others associated with Boof.

Peter "Boof" Rivers started playing for South Augusta in 1975 when he was recruited from West Torrens and played 118 senior games consisting of 58 A Grade games and 60 B Grade games playing his last game in 1990.

He won the SGL Dyason Medal as the Seconds Best and Fairest in 1987

Peter coached two B Grade Premierships in 1990 and 1991 and junior sides from 1995 to 1997 with his two sons Jess and Jared coming through the ranks.

He then progressed to A Grade coach where he was involved with two more Premierships in 2000 and 2012. In the 2000 Premiership both Jess and Jared played in the team.

Peter continued coaching in 2013 and retired at the end of that year.

Peter was involved in some capacity with the club as a player, coach or committee person for over 20 years and was awarded Life Membership in 2020.

Congratulations to ex-Southie Jak Kerin and Sally George on the recent arrival of Charlie Anthony. Maybe a future father-son recruit or grandfather-grandson recruit?

Great news that past Premiership player Jared Rivers has been appointed Assistant Coach at St Kilda. Jared played in the 2000 A Grade Premiership before playing at North Adelaide, Melbourne and Geelong. Jared will join St Kilda as a backline coach with his last stint with Collegians Football Club in the VFA steering them to a 2023 A Grade Premiership. Whilst on St Kilda great to see ex-junior Issac Keeler gaining a one-year contract extension with the Saints



Cazza's Gossip

This Month's we focus on past club champions:

Merv McKenzie,

Club Champion Merv McKenzie was made a Life Member in 1962 having played from 1953-1962 after being recruited from North Adelaide. In 1953 Merv won the league trophy and in 1959 played for Port Augusta in the tied game against Whyalla. In 1958 he was appointed captain coach and he played for Port Augusta on several occasions including 1960 where he polled well in the Mail Medal and also won the clubs Fairest and Best. He served on the South Augusta committee from 1964-1968 a total of 5 years.



Robert Nowak.

Life Member Robert Nowak played senior football for South from 1948-1964 playing 150 games for the club including the 1964 A Grade Premiership side. In 1959 Robert won the A Grade trophy for Best Centreman. From 1958-1962 he was on the Management Committee. He made the S.G.L side in 1961 and the Port Augusta side in 1962. In 1950 he was B Grade Vice Captain rising through the ranks to become a great player for the club.

Robert Farr,

Robert Farr played for South's from 1968 to 1979 playing over 150 senior games. Robert was involved in the 1979 B Grade Premiership. Robert was a mentor to the younger players at the club and was the club's Fairest and Best in 1975, the same year he was captain.





David Shillabeer,

David Shillabeer played for South from 1963 to 1978 being part of the 1964 A Grade Premiership side which defeated Port. David also played for Norwood for several years before returning to South Augusta. He was leading goalkicker A Grade on several occasions kicking 14 goals in one game against Central Augusta. David was the SGL leading goalkicker in 1973 and 1974.

David coached South's B Grade from 1978 to 1982 taking the team to six straight grand finals with four Premierships. David also coached the B Grade in 1987 and 1988 and served on South's Management Committee. David is a Life Member and a Hall of Fame member of the club.

Kevin Harris,

Kevin Harris played senior football from 1990-2008, playing 204A and 24B grade games. Kevin was a champion of the club having won the Fairest and Best trophy a record 5 times. Kevin represented the SGL and Northern Cities on several occasions and played in three A Grade Premierships in 1993, 1994, and 2006. Kevin is a Life Member and Hall of Fame member of the club.





Shane Kennedy,

Shane Kennedy played over 300 senior games for South's from 1987-2000 having played in B Grade Premierships in 1990 and 1991 and an A Grade Premiership in 2000. Shane has won several B Grade trophies during this time and was on the Management Committee from 1997 to 2001 being President over that time from 2002 to 2005 for 4 years. Shane is a Life Member and Hall of Fame Member of the club.
