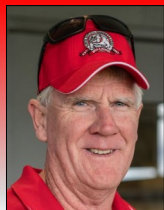

Thanks in advance to Zac Blinman who will take over the match day PlayHQ duties for 2023.

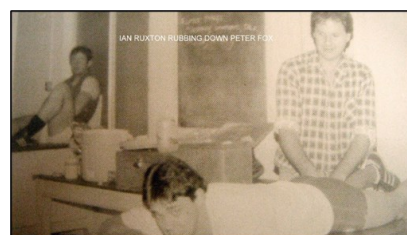
ANNUAL RAFFLE SERIES FUNDRAISER

Gazza's GOSSIP

For the next two months, I will focus on the Waterworth family and their involvement at the club over many years. This month I discuss Colin, Marg, Elsie, Jarrod and Jason.

Colin Waterworth: Colin played for the club between 1961 and 1973 and was captain of the 1972 seconds premiership team and member of the 1961 B Grade side. Colin has volunteered in a variety of capacities within the club including BBQ shed co-ordinator for several years and was Club President from 1992 to 1994 during the A Grade Premierships in 1993 and 1994. He served on the Management Committee from 1989 to 1994 and is a South Augusta Life Member and Life Member of the Port Augusta Colts Association, serving many years on the Colts Committee. He has been a hard working volunteer on counter meals, club functions and the oval BBQ, and a valuable sponsor of the club for many years.

Jarrold Waterworth: Jarrod played 200 League and 126 Seconds games between 1988 and 2007, including League premiership in 1993, 1994 and 2000; and two Seconds premierships. Jarrod won the League Best and Fairest award in 1996, was Runner-up in 2004 and was Vice-Captain from 1996 until 2000. He was Assistant League Coach in 2005, 2006, 2007 and 2012. He has also been a willing volunteer in all aspects of the club. He is also a Life Member of the Spencer Gulf Football League. Jarrod's son Jed is a great contributor to the club as a trainer and volunteer for Friday night tea announcements.

Jason Waterworth: Jason played senior football from 1989 to 2008 for a total of 184 League and 106 Seconds games, including the 2000 League Premiership. He was Seconds Captain in 1994. He is also a Life Member of the Spencer Gulf Football League. Jason's sons Will and Rex have played both A Grade and B Grade for the club and are current players. Jason's wife Tricia was awarded Life Membership last year.

Marg Waterworth: Mother of Jarrod and Jason and wife of Colin, Marg has been a true stalwart of the club for over 40 years. She is a regular volunteer at all club functions and worked tirelessly at the oval BBQ for almost two decades. Marg is a Life Member of the club. In 1991 and 2002 Margaret was selected as the Club Person of the Year for her outstanding contribution to the Club.

Elsie Hearne: Elsie is wife of the late Bob Hearne and is a Life Member of the club. Elsie is a sister to Harry and Colin and her husband Bob is also a Life Member. Bob was Club Secretary in 1970 to 1971 and he was a senior player from 1949 to 1963. Their three sons also played for Souths - Terry, John and Dennis. Elsie was a dedicated and long serving contributor to the club's Ladies Committee.

He was father and father-in-law of Sharyn and Sandy, Julie and John, Lynne and Gordon, Vicki and Mick, Briony and Tania, and was grandfather to six and great-grandfather to six. The club offers its belated condolences to the Hollingsworth family.

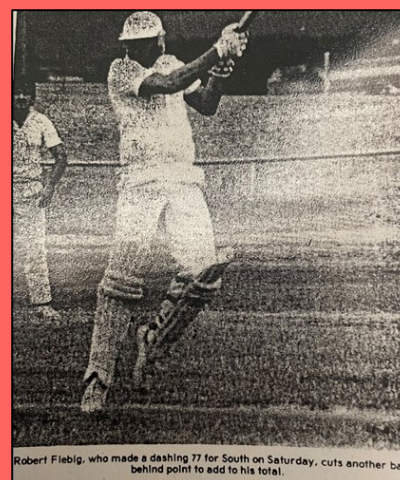

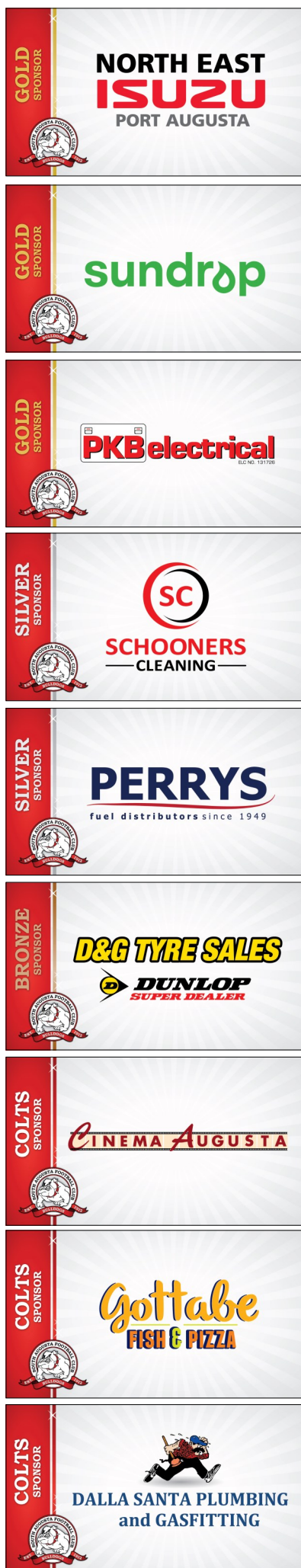
