South Augusta Yearbook 2018

After a huge pre-season movement of players into and out of the club the 2018 season got underway without 2017 premiership players Mark Horner, Josh Ackland, Brendon Colson and Co-captain Adam Grantham. On the plus side the return of eventual premiership players Lionel Brown, Greg Shirley and Jarryd Warren plus picking up eventual premiership players Kriston Thompson and Ronald Fuschtei balanced our losses.

Playing a rebuilding West in Round 1 saw a 114 point win followed by 47, 57, 29 and 88 point wins after playing each opponent once. Rounds 6 to 10 resulted in wins by 143, 40, 26, 33 and 86 points. The final five match ups saw wins by 74, 115, 46, 36 and 41 points. Thus having an undefeated season saw us win the minor premiership and set up another home Second Semi Final clash against Solomontown. A 47 point win saw us have a week off to prepare to defend our crown and make our own piece of history. Sollies got through the Preliminary Final to make it a second GF in a row between us. Thankfully this time the scores grew further apart as the game progressed (19 points at quarter time, then 31, 50 and 61 points at the end) and we had won our 22nd game in a row and more importantly our historical first ever threepeat .

Naturally we are now aiming for a fourpeat (a word I just invented) in 2019. I invite everyone to join us and do what you can to achieve this goal.

Individual highlights include Aziel Stuart winning the Madigan Medal with 20 votes and Matt Downey finishing second (for the second year in a row) with 16 votes. Lionel Brown took out the goalkicking trophy with 92 goals. When you add on the results in all four grades we were proud to have been awarded the Club of the Year.

Thanks to the players, coaches and Footy Committee for all your efforts this season which brought the ultimate reward.

Coach James Boles has had another great year at the helm taking out his third premiership in his third year of coaching the club with great help from the Football Committee in recruiting new players to the club.

The B's also had a great year playing in its fourth straight Grand Final and Second premiership in 4 years and we would like to thank Marcus Gill for his hard work and dedication as coach during the year in what is the hardest job at the club.

Our U/18's under Anthony Everett had a greatly improved year playing off in the Preliminary Final, several U/18's played 'A' grade footy. Well done Buck and the boy's who are the future of our club.

Many thanks also to those who worked on the Bar and Kitchen roster, particularly Peter Trewartha, our time keeper Rick Gill who does 3 or 4 games week in week out, our Trainers under Val Waterworth and our Drinks Stewards, Team managers and all other helpers in 2018. Thanks Mick Kerin
